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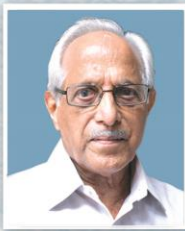

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Message of National Director for RSETIs, NACER



There has been a steady growth in the Indian economy for the past many years. Though this growth has brought in development across many sectors, there are many challenges, especially in providing gainful employment to the educated unemployed, school dropouts and illiterates among the Rural unemployed youth. The employment potential in the agricultural sector, which is characterized by disguised employment and under-employment, has reached a point of stagnation.

We are grateful that a well-coordinated professional effort to address this problem was made way back in 1982 by Poojya Dr. D Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in Karnataka in association with Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank to start Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institutes [RUDSETIs] to provide short term training with long term handholding to the unemployed youth.

It is indeed noteworthy that the training methodology and the best practices followed by these RUDSETIs are quite unique and this has resulted in a settlement rate of over 70%. The training methodology and the best practices followed by RUDSET Institutes have been adopted by the Ministry of Rural Development to replicate the same in all the RSETIs. The initiatives of various sponsor Banks in promoting the RSETIs has resulted in functioning of 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs as on date, providing gainful employment opportunities to many rural unemployed youths.

While the employment opportunity in Government/Public Sector is not increasing much, the growth in employment potential in Private Sector is not keeping pace with the growth in the number of youths seeking employment. With the increasing trend towards consumerism, the opportunities for Self-Employment, particularly in the Services Sector, are increasing by leaps and bounds. But the unemployed youth are not properly oriented towards Self-Employment. Consequently, they are not able to engage themselves in any productive activity and tend to become dejected in life. This is where our 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs can play a proactive role as Change Agents, orienting the unemployed youth towards entrepreneurship, imparting the required training, and providing escort services to enable them to set up their own ventures.

It is indeed a matter of pride that the RSETIs/RUDSETIs have **cumulatively trained 49.4 lakh** rural unemployed youth of which **35.6 lakh candidates have been settled up to 31.03.2024 i.e., above 72% settlement**. The **share of women candidates trained comes to above 68%**. Further, the performance during FY 2023-24 is **4.51 lakh (105% achievement) in training, 3.46 lakh (77%) in settlement, and 2.08 Lakh (61%) in credit linkage**. Successful entrepreneurs have not only become self-employed but have also provided employment to a number of people in their ventures. It is noteworthy that RSETIs/RUDSETIs have played a major role in transforming the job seekers into job providers.

I am happy to note that your RUDSETI is bringing out the **Annual Activity Report for FY 2023-24**. I take this opportunity to extend my congratulations to the Director and Team members of the RUDSETI for their outstanding achievement **in training, settlement, and Credit linkage**. My gratitude to Poojya Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Sri Karma Zimpa Bhutia, Joint Secretary (Skills), MoRD, Sri Santosh Kumar Tiwari, Director, MoRD, Sri. INTRODUCTION

With the rapid increase in population and proportionate decline in employment opportunities both in public and private sector due to implementation of economic reforms, the unemployment problem has become the major issue of the Nation. Though there were some initiatives here and there from both Government and Non Government sectors, the results were not in tune with the efforts and investment made. Thus, due to declining openings for wage employment, youth, the most dynamic force of the country / society become desperate and restless leading to social unrest, extremism and other related social disorders.

The great visionary, **Dr.D.Veerendra Heggadeji** visualized herculean problem of unemployment and decided to do something to tackle this problem. e-Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank, the two progressive banks also agreed to participate in this noble cause, led to the emergence of **RUDSET Institute** in 1982 at Ujire in D.K. District, Karnataka State. The organization grew with leaps and bounds and expanded length and breadth of our country. Today there are 27 institutes running in 17 states of India, constantly try to develop Technical as well as entrepreneurship skills in educated unemployed Rural youth to take up self employment ventures.

MISSION:

Empowering youth by motivating and training them, to take up self employment for income generation and sustained livelihood. Youth are encouraged to take part in the economic development of the society by making them self reliant and self-dependent. Youth are motivated to develop entrepreneurial qualities by building self confidence for personality development and thus eventually for the economic growth and development of the country.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY:

RUDSET Institute follow unique training methodology consisting of carefully evolved training modules to suit various programmes / courses, so that the trainees learn both technical skills as well as soft skills to become successful entrepreneurs. Basically our training programmes are short duration interventions with intensive coaching with extended hours. Unemployed youth both women and men in the age group of 19-45 years having ability to read and write local language i.e. Telugu and having aptitude to take up self employment ventures are eligible for training. Institute, besides free training also provides free residential accommodation and boarding. Thus, residential training facilitate collective learning and also enable trainees to have luxury of extended training hours whenever necessary.

Also sign White boards, Power Point presentations, motivational video clippings, simulation exercises, public address system, sophisticated computer lab, spacious class rooms with Godrej furniture and well ventilated spacious dormitory are some of the training facilities available at RUDSET Institute, Ananthapuramu. In one word "facilities of a corporate college are available for rural youth" at our Institute.

Apart from class room lectures and practicals, the training also include Field visits, interface with successful entrepreneurs, Bankers, Govt. officials etc., to make training more practical oriented. Participatory type of training is followed wherein trainees are given maximum scope to express their feelings, ideas etc., besides allowing them to interact freely with trainers. Much emphasis is on confidence building amongst the trainees. Behavioral exercises and role plays are also employed as methods to explain the concepts. Real life situations are created by simulation exercises and case studies so that the trainees can visualize the situations and help to internalize their competencies. Library facility is provided with the required study material pertaining to Hard Skills and Soft Skills. New additions are added to the library every year for the benefit of the trainees. Audio visual aids are used to supplement the class room training. Adequate training material is made available and accessible to the trainees to enable them to practice whenever the trainees are interested and inspired.

Individual counseling, follow up of the trainees for 2 years after training to help the trainees to take up self employment by maintaining rapport with financial institutions is the unique feature of post training support extended by the Institute. During the follow up, the trainees will be helped in preparation of project reports and to get financial assistance from Bank Branches.

TRAINING PROGRAMMES OFFERED:

The institute provides training in wide range of activities. All the trainings are carefully planned after scanning the environment, keeping in view the local needs and are designed with a purpose. All the trainings are aimed at overall development of the trainees wherein behavioral and managerial inputs are judiciously mixed with skill development in selected trade/activity.

I. Training to First Generation Entrepreneurs:

1. Agricultural EDPs : Dairy farming, Advanced dairy Development, Sheep rearing, Piggery Farming, Mushroom cultivation, Sericulture, Horticulture etc.,

2. Product EDPs : Jute Products manufacturing, Saree rolling, Women tailoring, Multi Product Manufacturing, Gems & Artificial Jewellery, Preparation of traditional Dolls etc.,

3.Process EDPs : Electrical Motor Re-winding and pump set maintenance, Multi Purpose Mechanism, Photography & Videography, Two Wheeler Servicing, Embroidery & Fabric Painting, Beauty Parlor Management, Multi-phone servicing programme, Hand pump & Bore Well Repairs and Computer DTP, Computer hardware, Computer Tally, CC TV Security alarm fire alarm installation etc.

General EDPs: Crash programme of Business management, Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme.

II. Programmes for established Entrepreneurs : Skill Upgradation Programmes and Growth Programmes.

III Rural Development and Human Resource Development Programmes :-
