

Message of National Director for RSETIs, NACER



There has been a steady growth in the Indian economy for the past many years. Though this growth has brought in development across many sectors, there are many challenges, especially in providing gainful employment to the educated unemployed, school dropouts and illiterates among the Rural unemployed youth. The employment potential in the agricultural sector, which is characterized by disguised employment and under-employment, has reached a point of stagnation.

We are grateful that a well-coordinated professional effort to address this problem was made way back in 1982 by Poojya Dr. D Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in Karnataka in association with SyndicateBank and Canara Bank to start Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institutes [RUDSETIS] to provide short term training with long term handholding to the unemployed youth.

It is indeed noteworthy that the training methodology and the best practices followed by these RUDSETIs are quite unique and this has resulted in a settlement rate of over 70%. The training methodology and the best practices followed by RUDSET Institutes have been adopted by the Ministry of Rural Development to replicate the same in all the RSETIs. The initiatives of various sponsor Banks in promoting the RSETIs has resulted in functioning of 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs as on date, providing gainful employment opportunities to many rural unemployed youths.

While the employment opportunity in Government/Public Sector is not increasing much, the growth in employment potential in Private Sector is not keeping pace with the growth in the number of youths seeking employment. With the increasing trend towards consumerism, the opportunities for Self- Employment, particularly in the Services Sector, are increasing by leaps and bounds. But the unemployed youth are not properly oriented towards Self-Employment. Consequently, they are not able to engage themselves in any productive activity and tend to become dejected in life. This is where our 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs can play a proactive role as Change Agents, orienting the unemployed youth towards entrepreneurship, imparting the required training, and providing escort services to enable them to set up their own ventures.

It is indeed a matter of pride that the RSETIs/RUDSETIs have cumulatively trained 49.4 lakh rural unemployed youth of which 35.6 lakh candidates have been settled up to 31.03.2024 i.e., above 72% settlement. The share of women candidates trained comes to above 68%. Further, the performance during FY 2023-24 is 4.51 lakh (105% achievement) in training, 3.46 lakh (77%) in settlement, and

2.08 Lakh (61%) in credit Linkage. Successful entrepreneurs have not only become self-employed but have also provided employment to a number of people in their ventures. It is noteworthy that RSETIs/RUDSETIs have played a major role in transforming the job seekers into job providers.

I am happy to note that your RUDSETI is bringing out the **Annual Activity Report for FY 2023-24.** I take this opportunity to extend my **congratulations to the Director and Team members of the RUDSETI** for their outstanding achievement **in training, settlement, and Credit linkage.** My gratitude to Poojya Dr.

02. BRIEF REPORT OF THE INSTITUTE

RUDSET Institute is an earnest initiative made by Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade to mitigate the problem of unemployment. It was established in the year 1982. The two leading nationalized Bank viz. Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank joined hands in this noble effort. The collective Thinking of Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Educational Trust and Canara Bank gave a concrete shape in providing an Institutional framework in form of Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institute (RUDSETI).

RUDSETI has now become a replicable model with Government of India establishing RSETIs in every district across the country, with the same pattern of education and training. Now the RSETIs have been opened in most of the Districts by the Concerned Lead Bank.

RUDSETI Bhopal is the 19th RUDSETI opened on 19th Sept. 2002. It is treated as a unique Institute, identifying, selecting, motivating and offering training to unemployed youth to take up self-employment. The Institute has travelled a glorious path of 22 years and has depicted excellent performance resulting in training of 15364 youth till 31.03.2024 with 71% Settlement. The Institute has coverage over 6 Districts including Bhopal.

Mission:

- > Channelizing youth power in wealth creation
- > Empower youth to share economic progress equitably.

Objectives:

- > Identify, orient, motivate, train and assist the rural youth to take up self-employment /wage employment ventures as an alternative career.
- > To take up research and development activities in entrepreneurship and rural development.
- Train village level worker to work in rural development.
- Counseling and project consultancy.

Training Programmes:

RUDSETI offers more than 64 types of Entrepreneurship Development Programmes (EDPs) in various avenues. All the programmes are of short duration intervention ranging from 06 days to 45 days.



a) For First Generation Entrepreneurs:

- Agricultural EDPs: Dairy Farming and vermi compost making, Mushroom Cultivation, commercial floriculture, Commercial Horticulture, Bee Keeping, Goat Rearing, Poultry, Gardening, Landscaping, Matsya Mitra and Pashu Mitra etc.
- <u>Product EDPs:</u> Women's Tailor, Men's Tailor, Homemade Agarbathi Maker, Soft Toys Maker and seller, Candle Making, Costume Jewelry Udyami, Jute Product Udyami, Papad, Pickle and Masala Powder Making, Paper Cover, Envelop and file Making and Vastra Chitrakala Udyami etc.
- <u>Process EDPs:</u> Electric Motor Rewinding and Repair Service, Photography & Videography, Cell Phone Repair and Service, CC TV Camera smoke detector and security alarm installation, Desktop Publishing, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, Computer Hardware and Networking, Beauty Parlour Management etc.
- General EDPs: Bank Mitra, General EDP, EDP to Persons with Disability, Community Resource Person Enterprises Promotion (CRP EP), Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme (REDP), PMEGP, EDP for Women etc.

b) For the Established Entrepreneurs:

- > Skill Up gradation: To improve the skills and enhance capability of the settled trainees.
- For the settled by trainees. To aim and achieve high goals in life and business for the settled trainees.

Rural Development and HRD Programmes:

- > Training Rural Development Facilitators of NGOs.
- > Training in SHG Management
- Training Bank Officials in Rural Development Activities.

Generation of Applications:

> The Institute gives wide publicity to its training programmes through print media/radio, mouth publicity of Ex. Trainees, through Sponsor Banks, Govt. Dept., NGOs and by organizing large number of Awareness Camps.

Eligibility of Candidate:

The candidate in the age group of 18-45 years belonging to the area of operation i.e. resident of Sehore, Vidisha, Rajgarh, Raisen, Bhopal and Betul districts can apply for the training. The candidate who can read and write in local language, has aptitude to take up self-employment or wage employment with some basic knowledge in the related filed can undergo training, which is totally free of cost.

Training Methodology:

- Identification and Selection of Candidates.
- > Campus and Practical Approach.
- Simulation Exercises, Group Discussion, Role Plays.
- Field Visits and Experience Sharing with Role models
- > Interaction with Bankers / Government Officials



Facility Offered:

- > Residential training with free Boarding and Lodging
- > Campus with Library and Audio- Visual Aids
- Workshop for Practical Approach to Training
- Experienced Trainers to train and motivate the trainees

Follow up:

The post training follow up of the trainees is the salient feature of the RUDSETI training, to sustain the motivational level and overcome problems faced by the trainees.

- > Two Year Follow up: Through Regular Correspondences, Door to Door visit, Branch level visit, Unit visit of the officials of the Institute etc.
- > Facilitating Credit Linkage with the banks for setting up of micro enterprises.

3. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

EDPs for first Generation

- Organized 31 training programmes.
- Trained 846 trainees by utilization of 569 training days.
- 19 programmes were conducted exclusively for women and trained 594 women.

Follow up

We have conducted 152 follow up and contacted 1540 candidates.

Awareness Programme

- ❖ We have Organized 76 Awareness Programmes covering 2756 youth.
- Our Institute has participated in Job fairs organized by NRLM & other Govt. Departments for mobilize & covering more and more youth.

Settlement

- 601 trainees have been settled during the year with the cumulative settlement rate of 71%.
- Of which 563 trainees are settled with selfemployment and 38 in wage employment.

Important Events

- ❖ We have completed 529 batches since inception and trained 15364 trainees with the settlement rate of 71%.
- ❖ We have organized 5 RUDSETI Stalls for creating awareness and publicizing RUDSETI activities.
- We have organized 4 RUDSETI Bazaars for marketing support of our trainees.

A. Training Programmes: - For first generation entrepreneurs

- 1. Six Agriculture EDPs were conducted and 186 trainees were trained.
- 2. Six Product EDPs were conducted and 188 trainees were trained.
- 3. Eleven Process EDPs were conducted and 264 trainees were trained.
- 4. Eight General EDPs were conducted and 208 trainees were trained.
- 5. Total 31 EDPs were conducted and 846 trainees were trained during the year.
- 6. Out of 31 EDPs, 31 EDPs were sponsored by NRLM Bhopal.

B. Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme:-

We have conducted 76 Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes during the year 2023-24 at various places. These Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes have benefited 2756 participants and helped in generating large number of applications for training needs.

C. Settlement: -

601 trainees were settled during the year, 380 trainees were settled by finance from Bank, 183 trainees were settled with own funds and 38 trainees were settled through wage employment. Total 10908 trainees were settled since inception. Settlement rate of our institute is 71 %.

D. Follow up: -

152 follow up meets were conducted and 1540 trainees were contacted during the year.
