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## Message

### Message of National Director for RSETIs

NACER There has been a steady growth in the Indian economy for the past many years. Though this growth has brought in development across many sectors, there are many challenges, especially in providing gainful employment to the educated unemployed, school dropouts and illiterates among the Rural unemployed youth. The employment potential in the agricultural sector, which is characterized by disguised employment and under-employment, has reached a point of stagnation. We are grateful that a well-coordinated professional effort to address this problem was made way back in 1982 by Poojya Dr. D Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in Karnataka in association with Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank to start Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institutes [RUDSETIs] to provide short term training with long term handholding to the unemployed youth. It is indeed noteworthy that the training methodology and the best practices followed by these RUDSETIs are quite unique and this has resulted in a settlement rate of over 70%. The training methodology and the best practices followed by RUDSET Institutes have been adopted by the Ministry of Rural Development to replicate the same in all the RSETIs. The initiatives of various sponsor Banks in promoting the RSETIs has resulted in functioning of 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs as on date, providing gainful employment opportunities to many rural unemployed youths. While the employment opportunity in Government/Public Sector is not increasing much, the growth in employment potential in Private Sector is not keeping pace with the growth in the number of youths seeking employment. With the increasing trend towards consumerism, the opportunities for Self Employment, particularly in the Services Sector, are increasing by leaps and bounds. But the unemployed youth are not properly oriented towards Self-Employment. Consequently, they are not able to engage themselves in any productive activity and tend to become dejected in life. This is where our 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs can play a proactive role as Change Agents, orienting the unemployed youth towards entrepreneurship, imparting the required training, and providing escort services to enable them to set up their own ventures. It is indeed a matter of pride that the RSETIs/RUDSETIs have cumulatively trained 49.4 lakh rural unemployed youth of which 35.6 lakh candidates have been settled up to 31.03.2024 i.e., above 72% settlement. The share of women candidates trained comes to above 68%. Further, the performance during FY 2023-24 is 4.51 lakh (105% achievement) in training, 3.46 lakh (77%) in settlement, and 2.08 Lakh (61%) in credit Linkage. Successful entrepreneurs have not only become self-employed but have also provided employment to a number of people in their ventures. It is noteworthy that RSETIs/RUDSETIs have played a major role in transforming the job seekers into job providers. I am happy to note that your RUDSETI is bringing out the Annual Activity Report for FY 2023-24. I take this opportunity to extend my congratulations to the Director and Team members of the RUDSETI for their outstanding achievement in training, settlement, and Credit linkage. My gratitude to Poojya Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Sri Karma Zimpa Bhutia, Joint Secretary (Skills), MoRD, Sri Santosh Kumar Tiwari, Director, MoRD, Sri. Hardeep Singh Ahluwalia, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri M. Bhaskara Chakravarthy, General Manager, FI Wing, Canara Bank, and the SRLM officials for their support and guidance from time to time.

## Message

### Message from State Director Haryana for RSETIs

I am happy to note that your Rseti/Rudseti is going to bring out Annual Activity Report for the FY 2023-24 as per the practice in vogue. First of all, I would like to congratulate all my Colleagues of Rsetis/Rudseti Family Haryana for showing improvement in achievement of the annual target from 95 percent in FY 2022-23 to 97 percent in FY 2023-24. As against the allotted target of 15675, our Rsetis/Rudseti of Haryana State had trained 15152 candidates representing 97 percent of achievement as against 105 percent achievement at the National level. On the other hand, our Settlement Rate and Bank Credit Linkages stood at 67 percent and 40 percent, respectively as against 77 percent and 61 percent, respectively at the National level. On a cumulative basis, since inception, as on March 31, 2024, 21 Rsetis/Rudseti of Haryana State had trained 163842 candidates. Out of which, 106064 candidates have been settled representing 64.7 percent of Settlement Rate as against 72.1 percent Settlement Rate achieved at the National level.



Friends, it is a general perception that banks, by and large, are conservative in extending loans to trainees from our Rsetis/Rudseti in the absence of their experience in the relevant field. Further, on our Rsetis/Rudseti part, when the loan application is submitted to Rsetis/Rudseti by the trainee, I shall expect from the Directors and Faculty Members to share (rather own) the responsibility and be in constant touch with LDM and Branch Managers so as to ensure that our trainees get their loan disbursed within the stipulated time as prescribed by the RBI. Here I would like to reinforce that Certificates to the trainees from our Rsetis/Rudseti are given after thorough scrutiny through Tests and Interview by a Third Party Agency. On the Assessment & Certification part, during FY 2023-24, in totality, 304 batches were assessed and 98.6% of the trainees have successfully passed their assessment. Segment-wise analysis reveals that 98.4% of the trainees have passed their assessment among the rural poor segment while under non-rural poor section, the success ratio was at 99.3%.

At this moment, I along with all my colleagues of Rsetis/Rudseti Family Haryana State sincerely thank & express deep sense of gratitude to respected National Director Shri G Murugesan Sir & his entire Team at NACER, Bengaluru, Shri R R Singh National Controller A&C Sir & his entire Team NAR, Bengaluru, Shri H Raghu Raj DG, NAR Sir & his entire Team at NAR Bengaluru for their valuable and timely guidance & support. My close association with Shri Shailender Chauhan Ji State Controller A & C has really helped us in smooth conduct & assessment of training batches, for which I along with all my colleagues of Rsetis/Rudseti Family Haryana profusely thank him. I would also like to thank Senior Functionaries of Govt. of Haryana, Regional Director, RBI Chandigarh, CGM, NABARD Chandigarh, CEO, SRLM Haryana, Top Management & Nodal Executives of PNB, Canara Bank & SBI, Convener, SLBC Haryana, Senior Functionaries of District Administration, AGM, FIDD, RBI Chandigarh, AGM, NABARD, SPM, LDMs, DPM, DIC, KVIC, KVIB & other stakeholders for their timely guidance, support & whole-hearted cooperation. Before I conclude, for the FY 2024-25, I would like to expect from all my colleagues of Rsetis/Rudseti Family of Haryana State to ensure biometric attendance of all the candidates (both in-campus & off-campus) and to include a couple of new training programs which are ready to earn besides vigorous follow-up with LDM and Branch Managers for timely disbursement of loans to our trainees, thereby ensuring significant improvement in Bank Credit Linkages & Settlement Rate.

## PREFACE

Unemployment is a curse to the society. It does not only impact the individuals but also the society, the country as a whole. There are number of factors that lead to unemployment. Education system is the main factor besides growth in population, slow economic growth, seasonal occupation, slow growth of industrial sector fall in cottage industry.

Education system in India focuses majorly on the theoretical aspects rather than skill development. Due to this varied education the youth is not able to sustain in this cut throat scenario thus adding to unemployment segment which has become biggest challenge in the country.

The survey, conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) between JULY 2017 and JUNE 2018 showed that the unemployment rate stood at 6.1 percent.

As per latest study, by 2022, over 500 million youth in the age group of 18-45 years will be available as human resource in our country, which if not channelized will pose biggest security threat to our social system. The bulk population of young unemployed youth is a serious concern to the planning makers.

### **Some of the consequences of unemployment are;**

- Increase in crime rate.
- Poor standard of living.
- Loss of skill.
- Slow economic growth.
- Mental health issues.
- Political instability.

Migration from rural areas to urban area causing extra pressure on amenities.

There are various barriers that are a major cause which stops the growth of the Indian entrepreneurs. The lack of adequate training, updated information on the various aspects of doing a successful business is one of such impediments an entrepreneur faces in the process of establishment of new enterprise.

The visionary Dr. D. VeerendraHeggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in the late 1980s visualized and analyzed this situation.

He emphasized upon retention of rural human resource at the village level only. Changing the mindset of rural youth was a herculean task. But he was determined to contribute in the nation building on this front.

The vision was three angled: -

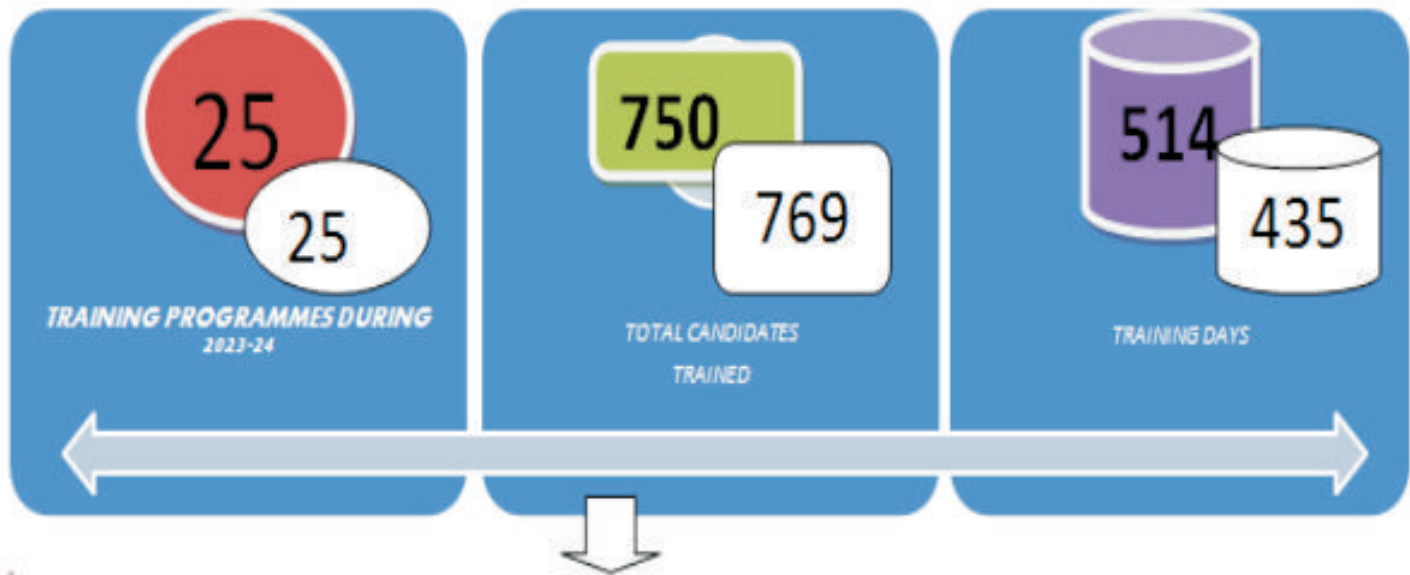
1. The rural youth is to be engaged with some employment enabling them to meet their livelihood.
2. Creation of employment should utilize the locally available resources.
3. Besides earning their livelihood, they would be able to create some employment opportunities to others.

These thoughts resulted in establishment of rural development self-employment training institute in 1982 at Ujire (Karnataka). This institutional frame work came into existence under the leadership of PadamVibhusham Dr. D. VeerendraHeggade, Dharam Adhikari, Dharmasthala with the hand holding support from SyndicateBank and Canara Bank. Now it is a matter of great satisfaction that RUDSETI has been able to deliver what was then expected from the promoters of the Institutes. In the past 37 years it has grown to 27 units of RUDSET Institute located in 17 different states. Our Gurugram unit was established on 04.08.1984.

RUDSETI, Gurugram has become prominent name for unemployed youth in the area of operation.

During current financial year 2023-24, 25 training programmes were conducted which constitutes 02 AGRI EDP, 11 PRODUCT EDP, 08 PROCESS EDP, 04 GENERAL EDP.

Training programmes conducted were mix of traditional activities like Jute Products, fast food Stall Udyami, Shopkeeper, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, Beauty Parlour Management.

During the financial year Five hundred Sixty Five (564) candidates were empowered to start micro enterprises / take up job employment.

**BUSINESS AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT:**

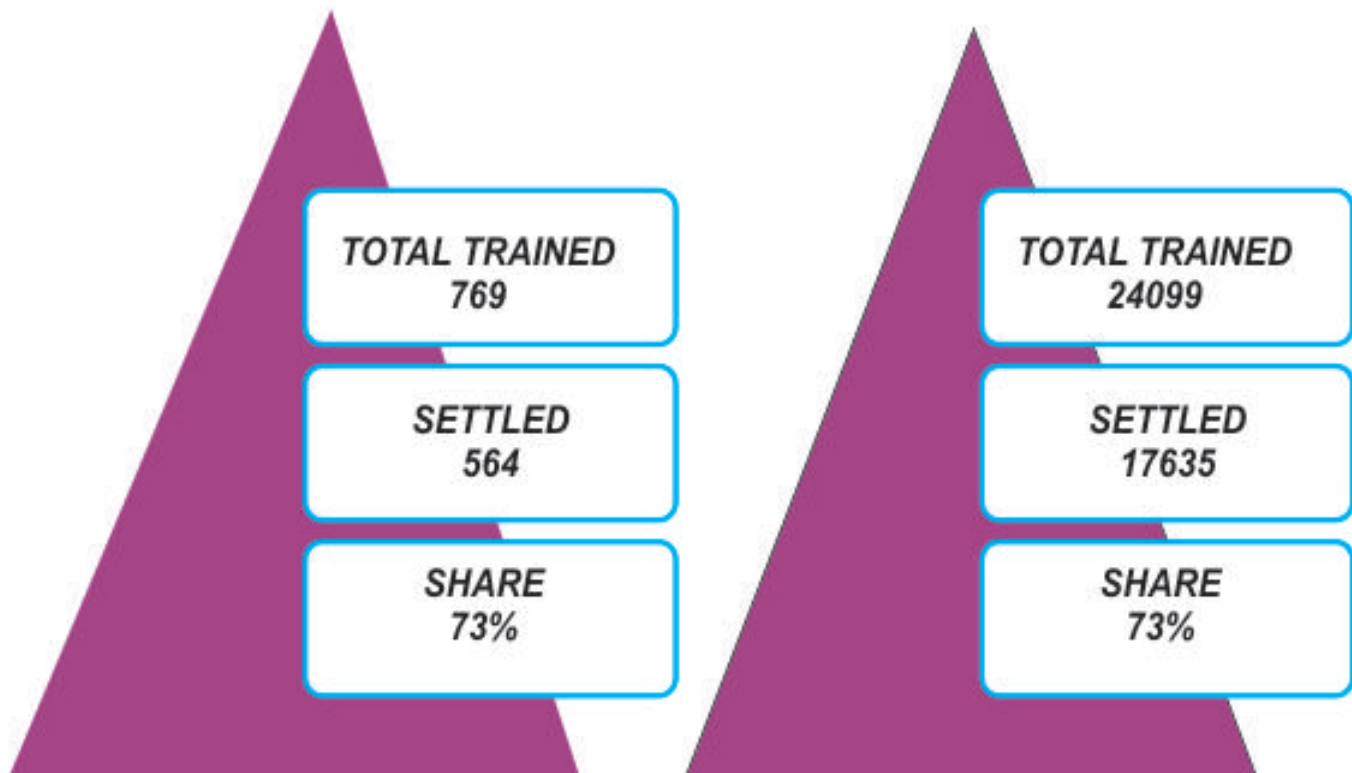
During this long journey of 40 years from 1984 to 2024, our Institute is catering services to appx 750 candidates per year.

The success of entrepreneurship training lies in the actual starting of the self-employment venture by the trainees or taking up the job employment.

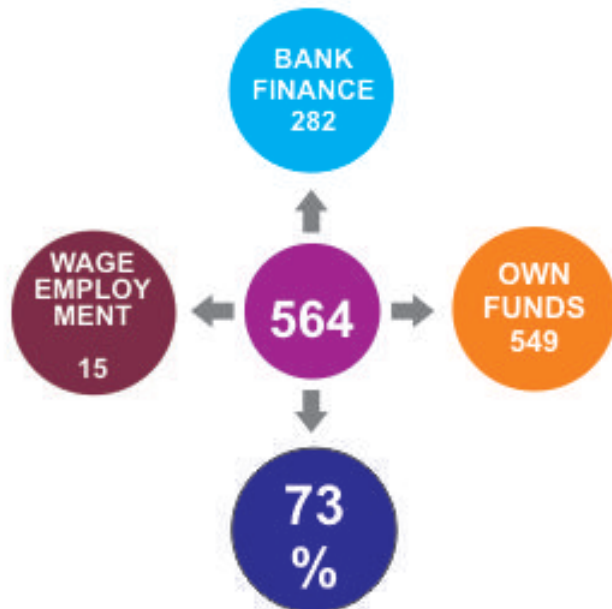
During this year 2023-24, **564** candidates were able to start their own ventures. We are proud to say that right from our inception, **24099** out of **17635** trained candidates have been settled either by self-employment or wage employment, which is 73% for our Institute. During the year **282** candidates were given financial help by bank branches to the tune of Rs. **58.28** Lakhs. Since inception Institute assisted **5989** candidates in securing bank finance aggregates over Rs. **5910.92** lakhs.



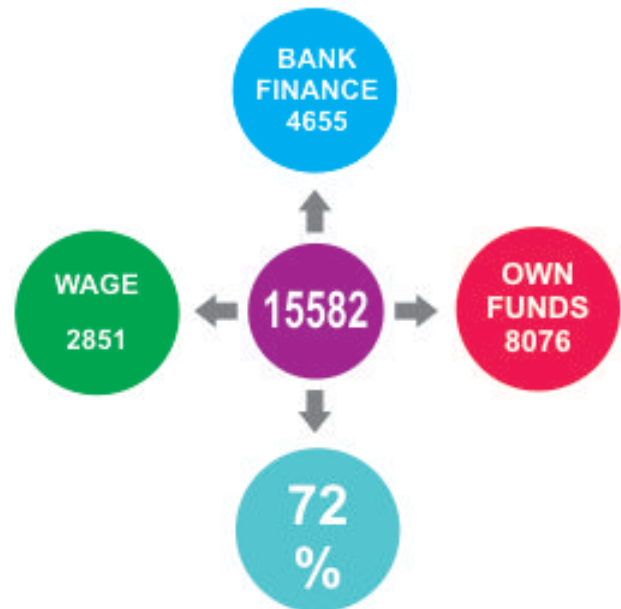

**DURING THE YEAR 2023-24**



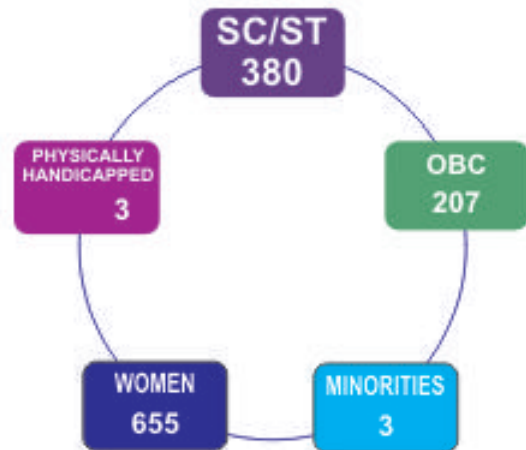
**SINCE INCEPTION I.E FROM 04.08.1984**



**SHARE OF WEAKER SECTION DURING THE YEAR 2023-24**

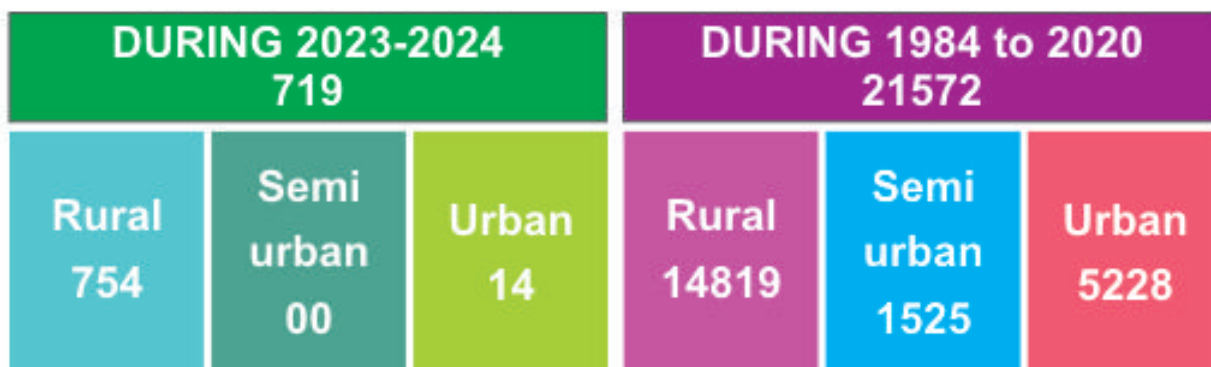
The weaker section received the major share of **590** of the trainees during the year.

A majority of the candidates trained this year hails from rural area.





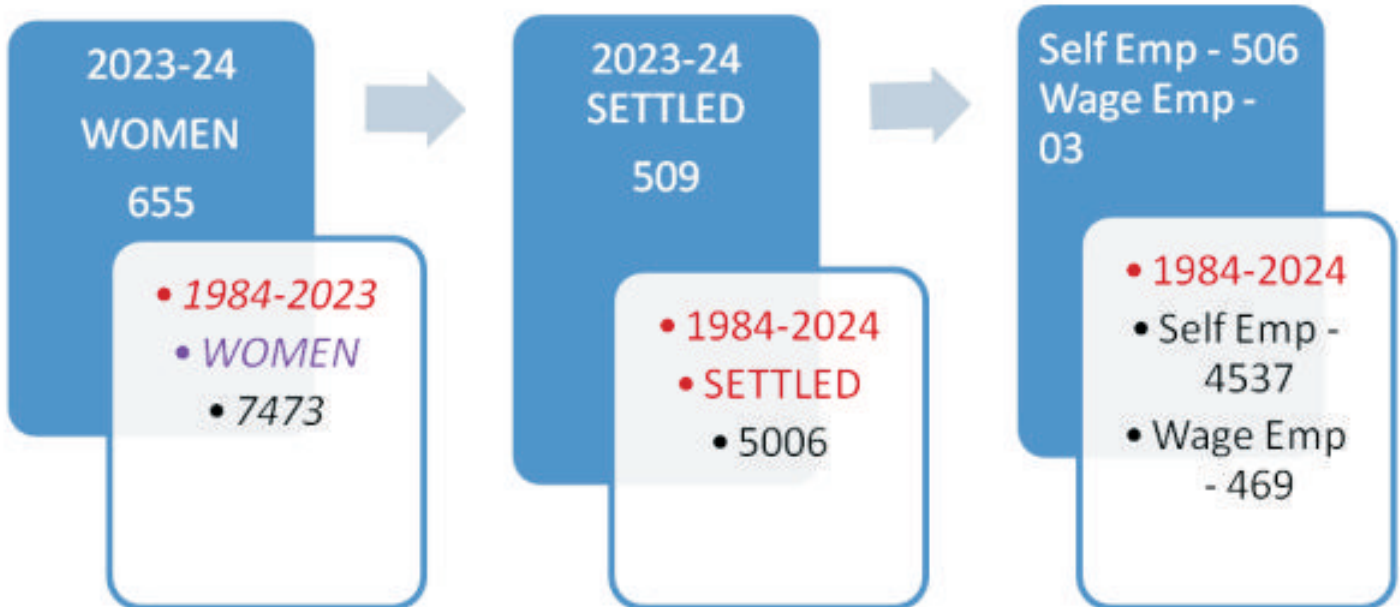
**WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:**

**509** women were able to reap the benefits and either started their self-employment ventures took the job employment (03).

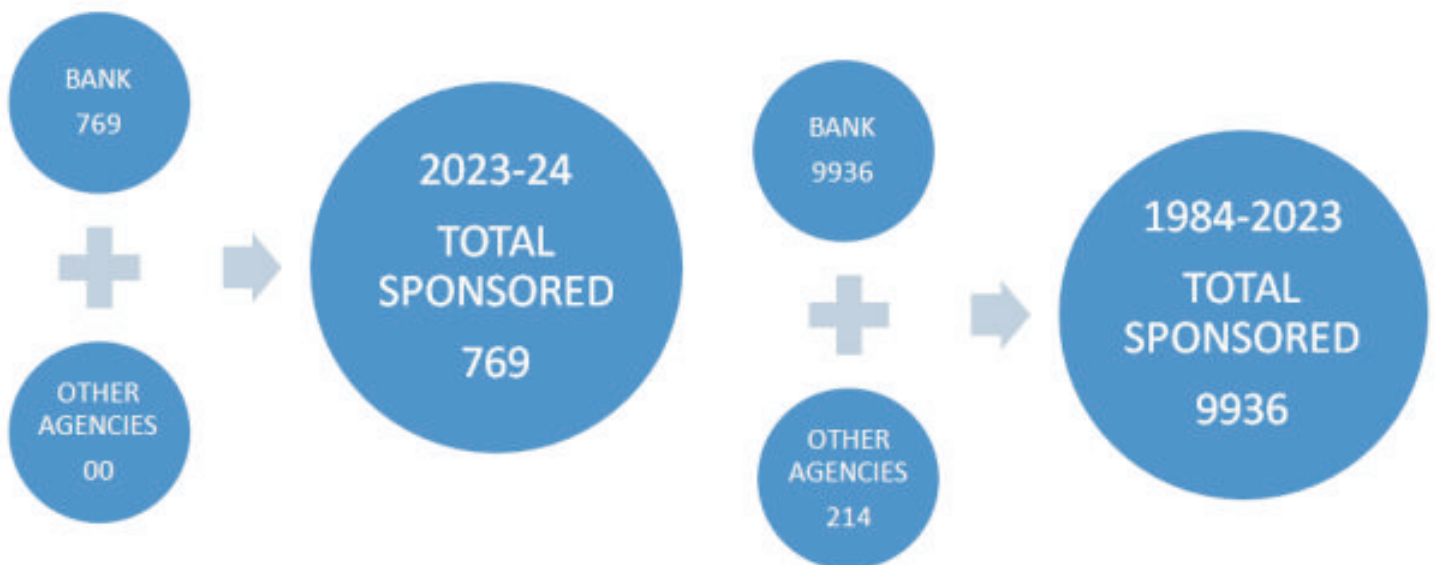
**278** women got credit linkage to the tune of **Rs 57.43 lacs** during the year.

### FOLLOW UP SERVICES

The cutting edge of RUDSETI training is the post training follow-up to sustain motivation level and to overcome teething problems of new enterprises. During this year we could contact 1089 candidates out of which through personal contacts in 112 spot meets.

### TRAINING DAYS

435 training days were utilized during this year to train 769 candidates in 25 programmes.

### ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

125 EAP Camps were organized during current year to reach 5256 unemployed youth. These camps were organized to motivate unemployed youth to take up self-employment ventures. Various agencies like Bank branches, NGOs like Nehru Yuva Kendra, Animal Husbandry Dept., Agriculture Dept. of Haryana Govt., Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Local authorities were associated.

**In its addition, 14 Sensitization programmes were also organized for 400 executive & officials.**

### EXPENDITURE

Recurring Expenditure during the year was **Rs. 52.58** lakhs as against **Rs. 49.28** lakhs spent last year.
