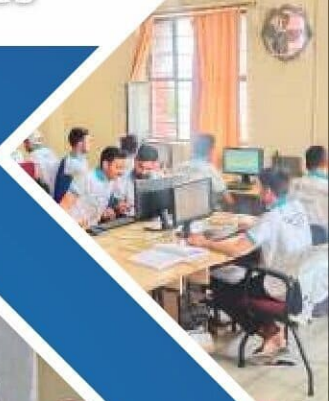

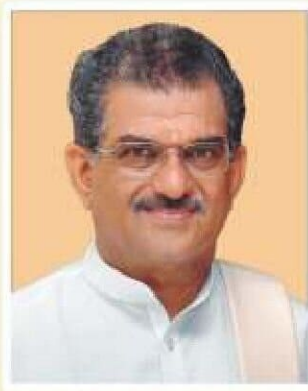

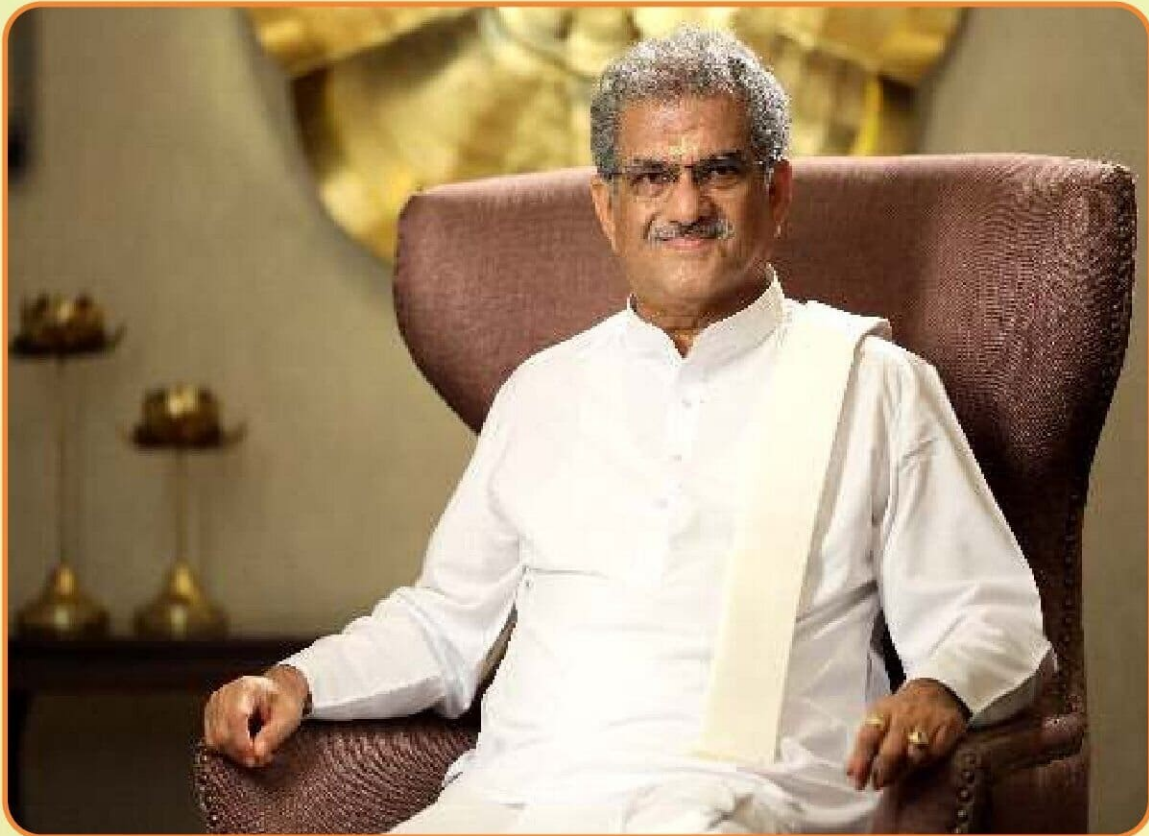

संस्थान द्वारा बेरोजगार युवाओं में स्वरोजगार के प्रति जागरूकता हेतु वर्ष 2022-23 में विभिन्न स्थानों पर 86 जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किये गये जो कि एक सराहनीय कदम है।

संस्थान द्वारा प्रशिक्षित प्रशिक्षणार्थियों में से अब तक 69 प्रतिशत युवाओं ने विभिन्न माध्यमों से स्वरोजगार / सेवा क्षेत्र द्वारा आजीविका प्राप्त कर ली है, जो कि बेहद प्रसन्नता की बात है।

Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs



RSETIs and RUDSETIs could resume normal functioning during the Financial Year 2022-23 after facing difficulties of COVID-19 during two consecutive years 2020-21 & 2021-22. All our RSETIs/RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objectives of the RSETI movement and performed exceedingly well with regard to the number of candidates trained, settled and Credit linked during FY 2022-23. As on 31.03.2023, there are 590 RSETIs/ RUDSETIs covering 572 Districts, functioning across the country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Govt. of India, which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/ RUDSETIs are providing training to the Rural unemployed youth in 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. The performance highlights of the RSETIs during FY 2022-23 are as under:

- As against the Annual Target of 4.04 lakh candidates, RSETIs have totally trained 4.10 lakh candidates (Achievement being 101%), of which 3.26 lakh candidates settled (80%) and 1.93 lakh candidates have settled with Credit linkage (60%).
- RSETIs are giving priority to mobilize a greater number of rural poor unemployed youth to give training according to their requirement. Thus, out of the total trained, the share of Rural Poor trained is 3.38 lakh (82%), of which 2.67 lakh candidates have settled (79%) and 1.75 lakh have settled with Credit Linkage (62%)
- In tune with the objectives of GOI, the RSETIs/RUDSETIs are giving more emphasis for women empowerment. Thus, out of total trained, the share of women candidates trained is 3.32 lakh (81%), of which 2.73 lakh candidates have settled (82%) and 1.75 lakh women candidates settled with credit linkage (65%)

I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors, Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) of the RSETIs/ RUDSETIs for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.

Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2022-23 and because of the collective efforts of the RSETIs and sponsoring Banks along with the active involvement of the State Directors (SDRs), who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with the respective Banks and SRLMs. I am pleased to inform you that the MoRD has released Rs. 187.02 Crore to various states during FY 2022-23, towards settlement of the pending claims. This is the first time in the history of the RSETIs that such a big amount is released in a particular Financial Year.

Another important milestone achievement during FY 2022-23 is that the SDRs in coordination with the sponsored Banks and NIRDPR have made major get through in the matter of construction of RSETI buildings. Thus, during the year many RSETIs have shifted to own buildings, in many cases the stopped building construction was resumed, in many cases building construction was commenced, in many cases land has been allocated. I am confident that with the same tempo, the quality of the training will be greatly improved with the shifting of many more RSETIs to own building during the FY 2023-24 also.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting ToT programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training.

The grading and CNN compliance status of RSETIs has been improved gradually and during the year 2021-22, 560 RSETIs have secured AA Grade and 566 RSETIs have complied with CNN. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is publishing Annual Activity Report-2022-23. On this occasion, I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all for the performance during FY 2022-23. I am confident that your RSETI will excel performance during FY 2023-24 also.

I take this opportunity to thank respected Sri Karma Zimpa Bhutia, Hon'ble Joint Secretary & Sri Santosh Kumar Tiwari, Hon'ble Joint Director, MoRD, GOI, Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Sri. Hardeep Singh Ahluwalia, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri A Muralikrishna, GM, FI Wing, Sri Amitava Sahu, DGM and Team of FI Wing of Canara Bank, HO Bengaluru and Nodal Executives of all RSETI sponsoring Banks for their full support which enabled us to show outstanding performance for the FY 2022-23.

A BRIEF REPORTING THE INSTITUTE

GENESIS:

Canara Bank and Syndicate Bank, the two progressive banks took the initiative in mitigating the unemployment problem under the leadership of Padmavibhushana Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, a great visionary and a religious head of a famous pilgrim center at Dharmasthala in Karnataka. The collective thinking gave concrete shape in providing an institutional framework, in the form of RUDSET Institute in 1982 at Ujire in Dakshina Kannada district of Karnataka. At Present 27 branches are spread over the country in 17 states.

SPONSORS:

The Institute is jointly sponsored by Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Educational trust, Erstwhile Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank.

VISION STATEMENT:

- * RUDSETI considers the youth as valuable human resource of the country to exploit the scope available in various avenues by launching the lucrative micro enterprises.
- * Transformation of youth into productive assets by short duration interventions.

OBJECTIVES:

- * Identify, orient, motivate, train and assist the rural unemployed youth to take up self employment ventures.
- * To take up research and development activities in entrepreneurship and rural development.
- * Train village level worker to work in rural development.
- * Counseling and project consultancy.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE:

RUDSET Institute offers more than 61 types of EDPs in various avenues. All the programmes are of short duration and residential training with free boarding & lodging. Duration ranging from ten day's to six weeks.

Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) for First Generation Entrepreneurs:

Agriculture EDPs : Agriculture and allied activity like Dairy Farming & Vermi Compost making, Poultry, Apiculture, horticulture, Sericulture. Mushroom Cultivation etc.

Product EDPs : Dress Designing for Men & Women, Leather & Rexene Utility Articles, Soft Toys Making, Cloth Bag Making, Handmade Paper Product, Fashion Designing, Food Processing, Artificial Jewellery etc.

Process EDPs : Electric Motor Rewinding & Pumpset Maintenance, Cell Phone Servicing, Servicing of TV/DVD and other Digital Electronics, Two Wheeler Servicing, Basic Photography & Videography, Installation of CCTV Camera & Security Alarm System, Computer Desk Top Publication, Computer Tally, Computer Hardware (A+) and Networking (N+), **Refrigeration & Air**

Conditioning, Domestic Electric Appliances Repair, Inverter Mfg. & Repair, Beauty Parlour Management Light Motor Vehicle Driving, Plumbing Works Course etc.

General EDPs : Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme (REDP), EDP PMEGP etc.

Wage Employment EDPs : Computerized Accounting.

Skill Up-Gradation EDPs : Advanced Digital Photography, Laptop Maintenance & Servicing, Advanced Mobile servicing, Advanced Beauty Parlour etc.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY ADOPTED ARE:

- Identification and selection of candidates
- Campus and practical approach.
- Simulation exercises, group discussions, role plays.
- Field visits and experience sharing with role models.
- Interactions with bankers / govt. officials.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TRAINING:

- For the first generation entrepreneurs-youth having aptitude to take up self-employment in the age group of 18-45 years, who can read & write local language.

FACILITIES OFFERED:

- Residential training with free boarding & lodging.
- Campus with Library and Audio Visual aids.
- Workshop for the practical.
- Yoga & Shramdana.
- Experienced trainer motivators.

ESCORT SERVICES:

The cutting edge of RUDSETI TRAINING is the Post training follow up for sustained motivation among the trainees. The effort to make them rise on to pinnacle includes:

- Two years follow up – Regular correspondences, individual contacts, unit visit, village/taluk/district/Branch level meeting – special follow up meeting involving bankers/govt. officials.
- Facilitating credit linkage with the banks for setting up of micro enterprises.
- Business linkage, workshops, seminars, etc.



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

“Another Excellence year” if we name the year 2022-23 in this way then we will not be exaggerating ourselves. The year once again proved to be the year of remarkable growth for us in different spheres of our activities. The Institute once again marked its presence among the one and all concerned. The confidence of our appreciation from SIDBI, NABARD, RGAVP, Nagar Nigam Jaipur, KVIC, DIC, Zila Parishad DRDA & Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India, Delhi, Bankers etc. boosted our moral to sky.

Among the various successful achievements of the year a few are listed below.

- We have conducted 31 entrepreneurship development programmes for the first-generation entrepreneurs as against the target 29.
- We have trained 830 unemployed youth during the year against the target of 870.
- Due emphasis was given to the upliftment of women 75% of our total trainees were women.
- We recorded the settlement of 602 trainees during the year, thus achieving the settlement rate of 72% for the year and an overall settlement rate is 69%.
- The socially and economically weaker sections of the society viz. scheduled caste. Scheduled tribe, backward classes and minority communities received due preference. As much as 88 % trainees pertain to this segment.
- The Institute has made sincere efforts in publicizing its activities among wider segments of society. For the purpose the Institute has conducted 86 awareness camps to counsel 3091 potential trainees.
- The branches of Sponsoring Banks and other Banks financed up to the tune of Rs. 80.60 lacs to 466 candidates.
- Director has attended 4 DLRC and 4 DCC meetings during the year.
- 1 HRD Programmes organized during Armed Guard training programme for Canara Bank conducted at our Institute from 06.12.2022 to 08.12.2022.
- 30 Sensitization programmes were organized during the year. +
