

The above achievement happened because of good liaison and co-ordination with in departments. I sincerely thank each and every stake holder who has extended their support to RUDSETI.

Message of National Director for RSETIs, NACER



There has been a steady growth in the Indian economy for the past many years. Though this growth has brought in development across many sectors, there are many challenges, especially in providing gainful employment to the educated unemployed, school dropouts and illiterates among the Rural unemployed youth. The employment potential in the agricultural sector, which is characterized by disguised employment and under-employment, has reached a point of stagnation.

We are grateful that a well-coordinated professional effort to address this problem was made way back in 1982 by Poojya Dr. D Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in Karnataka in association with SyndicateBank and Canara Bank to start Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institutes [RUDSETIS] to provide short term training with long term handholding to the unemployed youth.

It is indeed noteworthy that the training methodology and the best practices followed by these RUDSETIs are quite unique and this has resulted in a settlement rate of over 70%. The training methodology and the best practices followed by RUDSET Institutes have been adopted by the Ministry of Rural Development to replicate the same in all the RSETIs. The initiatives of various sponsor Banks in promoting the RSETIs has resulted in functioning of 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs as on date, providing gainful employment opportunities to many rural unemployed youths.

While the employment opportunity in Government/Public Sector is not increasing much, the growth in employment potential in Private Sector is not keeping pace with the growth in the number of youths seeking employment. With the increasing trend towards consumerism, the opportunities for Self-Employment, particularly in the Services Sector, are increasing by leaps and bounds. But the unemployed youth are not properly oriented towards Self-Employment. Consequently, they are not able to engage themselves in any productive activity and tend to become dejected in life. This is where our 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs can play a proactive role as Change Agents, orienting the unemployed youth towards entrepreneurship, imparting the required training, and providing escort services to enable them to set up their own ventures.

It is indeed a matter of pride that the RSETIs/RUDSETIs have cumulatively trained 49.4 lakh rural unemployed youth of which 35.6 lakh candidates have been settled up to 31.03.2024 i.e., above 72% settlement. The share of women candidates trained comes to above 68%. Further, the performance during FY 2023-24 is 4.51 lakh (105% achievement) in training, 3.46 lakh (77%) in settlement, and 2.08 Lakh (61%) in credit Linkage. Successful entrepreneurs have not only become self-employed but have also provided employment to a number of people in their ventures. It is noteworthy that RSETIs/RUDSETIs have played a major role in transforming the job seekers into job providers.

I am happy to note that your RUDSETI is bringing out the **Annual Activity Report for FY 2023-24.** I take this opportunity to extend my **congratulations to the Director and Team members of the RUDSETI** for their outstanding achievement **in training, settlement, and Credit linkage.** My gratitude to Poojya Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Sri Karma Zimpa Bhutia, Joint Secretary (Skills), MoRD, Sri Santosh Kumar Tiwari, Director, MoRD, Sri. Hardeep Singh Ahluwalia, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri M. RUDSETI MADURAI - Brief

Introduction:

Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, **Padma Vibushan Awardee** and Dharmathikari of Shreekshetra Dharmasthala, who has a great visionary started the RUDSET movement in association with Syndicate Bank and Canara bank. The first institute at Ujire came into existence in the year 1982. At present there are 27 RUDSETIs located in different states of India. The Tamilnadu unit was started in the year 02.02.1987 at *T.Andipatti* (near *Vadipatti*) in Madurai district. The Unit was shifted during 1997 to its spacious own premises at *Perungudi*, (near Airport) Madurai and since then it is functioning from there. As our land and premises acquired by Indian Airport Authority for their expansion purpose, now we have shifted our Institute to a rental premises belongs to Arulmigu Lord Sri Subramaniya Temple, Tirupparankundram which is situated at Balaji Nagar, Opp to Poonga Nagar Bus Stop, Tirupparankundram, Madurai.

Vision

Empowering youth to share economic progress equitably and channelizing youth power in wealth creation.

Mission

Developing RUDSETIs as rural resources centers for training and facilitating unemployed youth for setting up of Micro Enterprises, resulting in sustainable livelihood and improved living standards.

Philosophy


Transformation is unemployed rural youth to acquire productive identity through short duration interventions.

Core Objectives

- 1. To identify, orient, motivate and train youth to take-up self-employment ventures.
- 2. To assist trained youth to set up their ventures successfully.
- 3. To provide counselling and consultancy guidance and to render all possible help to the youth in the field of self-employment.
- 4. To take up research and development activities in the area of self-employment and rural development.

Management

The Board of Governors consisting of Chief Executives of sponsor Banks are the supreme policy making body. The Governing Council with Executives of sponsor organisations implements these policies. The Central Secretariat with an Executive Director, an Officer deputed by sponsor Banks aids Governing Council in monitoring RUDSETIS.




Each RUDSETI has a District Level RSETI Advisory Committee (DLRAC) with representatives of Sponsor Organisations and Govt. Officials. It periodically reviews and assists the progress of RUDSETI. Each RUDSETI is managed by one Deputed Officer (Director) from one of the Sponsoring Bank (Canara Bank). The Director is accompanied by trainer motivators (Faculties) trained by Central Secretariat, Ujire, through National Academy of RUDSETI (NAR) and other reputed organizations along with Office Assistants, Attender and Gardener.



Types of Training

I Programmes for first generation entrepreneurs.

The Training Programmes are classified in four catagories:



II. Programmes for established entrepreneurs:

- 1. Skill Up-gradation/ High End Techno & Managerial Enhancement training Programme: Programmes intended to impart additional / advanced skills in their chosen field.
- 2. **Growth Programme:** Training cum counselling inputs are given to help entrepreneurs to plan their expansion, diversification, improve the profit margin, withstand the future challenges etc.

Eligibility norms

Any unemployed youth in the age of **18-45 years**, irrespective of caste, creed, religion, gender and economic status having aptitude to take up self employment or wage employment with some basic knowledge in the related field can undergo training which is totally free of cost. **National Skill Qualification framework (NSQF) Syllabus,** as framed by Ministry of Skill Development and

Entrepreneurship (MSDE) and adopted by Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), is followed and our training programmes are conducted.



Facilities

The institute was located in a **spacious area** measuring about 81 cents on the Airport main Road. There was a beautiful ambience filled with green and breezy open space for **yoga and playing games**. The Main building houses the **office, Library, Two learning rooms and a Computer lab**. Library is endowed with latest books, project reports etc. There are sufficient enough infrastructures like AV equipments, computer facility, electric circuit learning board etc., The **workshed** is provided with training materials, tools equipments and mockup models etc. for imparting practical training. Now the training institute has been shifted to a rental premises belongs to Arulmigu Sri Subramaniya Swamy Temple, Tirupparankundram, Madurai which is situated at Balaji Nagar, Opp to Poonga Nagar Bus Stop, Tirupparankundram, Madurai with all the basic required infrastructure facilities. The entire training is given at **free of cost,** including **boarding & lodging.**

Post training follow-up

The in-built system of follow-up and counseling/Hand holding for 2 years is a unique feature of RUDSETI trainings. The follow-up measures with trainees include regular correspondence, individual contacts, branch level meets, Cluster meets Door to Door visits, etc. Our guidance and counseling during these interactive sessions assist the trainees to sort out their problems in launching and sustaining their own self employment ventures.


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR 2023-2024


- Against the target of 28 programmes planned this year, we have conducted 28 programmes covering 862 trainees against the target of 850 with the training days 510 days against the target 510.
- Out of total 28 programmes, 13 programmes were conducted exclusively for women candidates.
- ➤ 105 Entrepreneurs Awareness Programmes, (EAP) conducted spreading the message of "Prosperity through Entrepreneurship" to 3427 youths.
- > 443 follow up meets were conducted and 3634 ex-trainees were contacted for hand holding and counseling
- > 730 trainees settled and settlement rate during the year is 84% and cumulative settlement rate is 76%.
- Out of 862 trainees trained, 808 are from rural background which constitutes about 93 %
- ➤ **Weaker section** of the society contributed the paramount share of our trainees (i.e.,) **730 candidates** (**84%**).
- ➤ Shri. T.R.Sundarachary, Director, RUDSETI Madurai received the **District Level Best Performer award** in Rural Development through Capacity Building on the 75thRepublic Day celebrations on 26.01.2024 **(2022-23)** from the District Administration Madurai.


