Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs

RSETIs and RUDSETIs could resume normal functioning during the Financial Year 2022-23 after facing difficulties of COVID-19 during two consecutive years 2020-21 & 2021-22. All our RSETIs/RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objectives of the RSETI movement and performed exceedingly well with regard to the number of candidates trained, settled and Credit linked during FY 2022-23. As on 31.03.2023, there are 590 RSETIs/ RUDSETIs covering 572 Districts, functioning across the country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Govt. of India, which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/ RUDSETIs are providing training to the Rural unemployed youth in 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. The performance highlights of the RSETIs during FY 2022-23 are as under:



- As against the Annual Target of 4.04 lakh candidates, RSETIs have totally trained 4.10 lakh candidates (Achievement being 101%), of which 3.26 lakh candidates settled (80%) and 1.93 lakh candidates have settled with Credit linkage (60%).
- RSETIs are giving priority to mobilize a greater number of rural poor unemployed youth to give training according to their requirement. Thus, out of the total trained, the share of Rural Poor trained is 3.38 lakh (82%), of which 2.67 lakh candidates have settled (79%) and 1.75 lakh have settled with Credit Linkage (62%).
- In tune with the objectives of GOI, the RSETIs/RUDSETIs are giving more emphasis for women empowerment. Thus, out of total trained, the share of women candidates trained is 3.32 lakh (81%), of which 2.73 lakh candidates have settled (82%) and 1.75 lakh women candidates settled with credit linkage (65%).

I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors, Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) of the RSETIs/ RUDSETIs for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.

Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2022-23 and because of the collective efforts of the RSETIs and sponsoring Banks along with the active involvement of the State Directors (SDRs), who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with the respective Banks and SRLMs. I am pleased to inform you that the MoRD has released Rs.187.02 Crore to various states during FY 2022-23, towards settlement of the pending claims. This is the first time in the history of the RSETIs that such a big amount is released in a particular Financial Year.

Another important milestone achievement during FY 2022-23 is that the SDRs in coordination with the sponsored Banks and NIRDPR have made major get through in the matter of construction of RSETI buildings. Thus, during the year many RSETIs have shifted to own buildings, in many cases the stopped building construction was resumed, in many cases building construction was commenced, in many cases land has been allocated. I am confident that with the same tempo, the quality of the training will be greatly improved with the shifting of many more RSETIs to own building during the FY 2023-24 also.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting ToT programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training.

The grading and CNN compliance status of RSETIs has been improved gradually and during the year 2021-22, 560 RSETIs have secured AA Grade and 566 RSETIs have complied with CNN. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is publishing Annual Activity Report-2022-23. On this occasion, I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all for the performance during FY 2022-23. I am confident that your RSETI will excel performance during FY 2023-24 also.

As against the target of 17915 for both the States put together, we could train 18130 candidates during 2022-23. Not only under training, all our RSETIs have achieved the set targets under Settlement and Bank linkage, which was duly applauded by NACER & MoRD. All our RSETIs are ready for bagging "AA" grading for 2022-23 also.

It is heartening to learn that RUDSETI, Ongole is coming out with its Annual Activities Report for the year 2022-23 incorporating the entire gamut of activities of the Institute. I am glad to note that the RUDSETI has trained 825 candidates by conducting 30 programmes during FY 2022-23 against the target of 820 and achieved a Settlement rate of 71% with 50% Bank linkage. I whole heartedly congratulate and appreciate the commitment of Sri P Pratap Reddy, Director and all Staff members for this wonderful performance and keeping the standards of the Institute high with excellent coordination with District administration and Sponsor Bank Management.

I wish that Team RUDSETI, Ongole will continue their commitment with renewed vigor and enthusiasm by conducting more innovative/ needy Skill development programmes during the year 2023-24 with more focus on sustainable Settlement and Credit linkage to take the RSETI flag to newer heights in the coming days.

INTRODUCTION TO RUDSET INSTITUTE

GENESIS:

Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheswara Educational Trust and Canara Bank took the initiative under the visionary leadership of '**Padma Vibhushan Dr.D.Veerandra Heggade**' in the year 1982 to mitigate the unemployment problem in the country. The collective thinking gave concrete shape in providing an institutional framework of RUDSETI. In 1982, first institute was established at Ujire, Dakshina Kannada district, Karnataka. In the year 1988 RUDSET Institute was established at Vetapalem in Prakasam District and the same was shifted to a modern building complex at Bagyanagar Ongole in the year 2014.

MISSION:

- ❖ Channelizing youth power in wealth creation.
- ❖ Empower youth to share economic progress equitably.

PHILOSOPHY:

Transformation of rural youth into productive assets by short duration interventions. This is achieved by bringing technology, training and credit within their reach.

OBJECTIVES:

- ❖ Identify, orient, motivate, train and hand hold the rural youth to take up self-employment ventures.
- ❖ To take up research and development activities in Entrepreneurship and Rural Development.
- ❖ Train village level workers to work in rural development.

MANAGEMENT:

The Board of Governors consisting of Chief Executives of sponsors is the supreme policy making body. The Central secretariat with an Executive Director, an officer deputed by sponsor banks aids Governing Council in monitoring RUDSETI. Padma Vibhushan Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheswara Educational Trust, is the President of the Board of Governors as well as Governing Council.

Each RUDSETI has a District level RSETI Advisory Committee (DLRAC) with representatives of sponsor organizations, Government Officials and eminent personalities. It periodically reviews and assists the progress of RUDSETI.

A Manager is deputed from the sponsor bank who heads the institute as director and monitors the total functioning of the institute. The institute has a command area which comprises the whole of Prakasam District.

TRAINING WITH A PURPOSE:

Every Institute has evolved need based location specific training programs. They continuously scan the environment and evolve new training program. There are more than 60 training programs. They are short-term intensive courses ranging from 10 days to 60 days.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY:

- ❖ Identification & selection of candidates.
- ❖ Campus and practical approach.
- ❖ Simulation exercises, group discussions, role plays.
- ❖ Field visits & experience sharing with role models.
- ❖ Interactions with Bankers / Govt. officials, NGO's, Veteran Representatives.
- ❖ Personality development with Soft skills & Career path guidance.

FACILITIES OFFERED:

- ❖ Residential training with free boarding & lodging.
- ❖ Campus with Library & Audio-Visual aids.
- ❖ Workshop for the practical's.
- ❖ Experienced trainer motivators.
- ❖ Yoga, Meditation and Shramadan are taught.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO GET INTO RUDSETI PROGRAMMES:

- ❖ **For the first Generation Entrepreneurs-** Youth having aptitude to take up self-employment in the age group of 18-45 years, who can read and write local language.
- ❖ **Criteria for RD, HRD and Technology Programs** are determined in consultation with the program sponsors.

ESCORT SERVICES:

The Cutting edge of **RUDSETI** training is the Post Training follow-up/ hand holding for sustained motivation of the trainees.

- ❖ Trained youth are monitored/ followed up closely for two years. Regular correspondences, individual contacts, unit visit, Village/Taluk/District/Branch level meeting and special follow up meetings involving bankers/Govt. officials.
- ❖ Facilitating credit linkages with the banks for setting up self-employment units.
- ❖ Business linkage, Workshops, Seminars, etc.

WHAT SETS US APART:

- ❖ High settlement rate of 70% - Average of the RUDSET Institutes.
- ❖ Visionary leadership provided by Dr.D.Veerandra Heggade supported by the leading nationalized bank i.e Canara Bank.
- ❖ Free training with free food & accommodation.
- ❖ Campus approach with unique training methodology.
- ❖ Excellent facilities for hands on/practical training.
- ❖ Need based, area specific programs are conducted.
- ❖ Alumni becoming trainers and imparting training.
- ❖ Short term training with two years' post training follow- up.
- ❖ Transformation of settled trainees into trainers at many units of RUDSETI.

The trained entrepreneurs from the units of RUDSETI participate in the event.






