All RUDSET Institutes have achieved the individual trainee target along with the stipulated settlement and credit linkage parameters. The Institutes are in readiness to comply the Common Norms Notification and other important parameters during Annual Grading Exercise by MoRD/NACER.

The eco system in RSETI 1.0 was consolidated during the last 16 years with value additions like Annual Grading, Common Norms Notification etc. The comprehensive trainee assessment system in RSETIs developed under the guidance of National Council for Vocational Training and Education (NCVTE) has brought a visible recognition for RSETI training programmes under the new education policy.

We place on record our gratitude to MoRD/SRLM/NACER for their coordinated efforts in the release of long pending rural BPL claims.

As per the modus operandi planned for launching of AAP 2024-25 with challenging targets under various parameters, most of the RUDSET Institutes have commenced training programmes during first/second/third week of March 2024, so that they are completed in April 2024 exhibiting good progress during first month of the year itself. This will set up a momentum for continuous conduct of training programs throughout the year, which makes the efforts to achieve the challenging targets set by MoRD/NACER more meaningful and realistic.

RUDSET Institutes have a conspicuous identity among the 595 RSETIs established PAN INDIA under the aegis of MoRD. RUDSETIs have been sharing their expertise with other stakeholders in the movement. We shall continue with sincere commitment to carry forward the vision of our beloved President **Dr D Veerendra Heggade** in meeting the aspirations of unemployed youth of India.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PERFORMANCE DURING 2023-24

The Board of Governors and Governing Council members of RUDSETI take great pleasure in presenting the Activities Report on the working of all 27 units of RUDSET Institute during the year 2023-24. The significant contribution of RUDSETI in the entrepreneurial movement, propelling the youth to self-reliance, has indeed helped thousands of youth on the path of prosperity and identity.

During the year, RUDSETIs have conducted new training programmes to benefit the vulnerable sections of the society. Prominent among them are training programmes to Jail Inmates and Differently Abled People.

AWARENESS ON SELF-EMPLOYMENT

RUDSETI is spreading awareness on self-employment by organising Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes in rural areas. During the year, RUDSETI organised **2,919** awareness camps on self-employment in association with bank branches, social clubs and Government Departments to motivate **1.28** lakhs unemployed youth to take up self-employment ventures. Since inception, RUDSETI has organised **36,832** awareness camps involving **26.01** lakhs unemployed youth.

TRAINING

During the year, RUDSETI organised **783** training programmes and trained **22,264** unemployed youth to take up Self Employment ventures. Among them **4,191** candidates were trained in Agriculture and Allied Activities, **4,387** in Small and Micro Industries, **7,679** in Service Enterprises and **6,007** in Trade and General Sectors. Of this, as many as **15,012** women (**67%** of the total trained) were trained in different self-employment training programmes. Since inception, RUDSETI has trained **5,62,880** unemployed youth to take

up Self Employment ventures through **18,592** training programmes. The number of women trainees stood at **2,70,662** which works out to **48**% of the total trained.

SKILL UPGRADATION PROGRAMMES

In order to help the RUDSETI-trained candidates in acquiring latest technology in their field of activity, 10 Skill Upgradation programmes were organised, thus benefiting 214 entrepreneurs. Rapid change in the technology in all walks of life is the vital reason which prompts units to organise Skill Upgradation by which settled trainees are better equipped with latest technology in their trade and enabled to face the competition. Since inception, 497 Skill Upgradation programmes have been conducted benefiting 10,893 entrepreneurs.

SETTLEMENT

During the year, 17,011 RUDSETI trained youth started their own enterprises and various Bank branches assisted 9,907 entrepreneurs by granting financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 42.14 crores. So far, 4,14,834 youth trained by RUDSETI have started their own enterprises thus, taking the cumulative start-up rate to 74%, which is a remarkable achievement. 1,86,002 candidates trained by us have so far availed financial assistance from various banks to the tune of Rs. 2312.79 crores for starting the ventures.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

58 Rural Development Programmes were organised to train **2,351** participants during the year. The programmes were conducted for the benefit of farming community and other rural folk. Since inception, **1,874** Rural Development Programmes have been organised to benefit **88,267** participants.

HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (HRD) PROGRAMMES

During the reporting year, **83** Human Resource Development Programmes were organised to train **3,730** participants. Since inception, **1,288** HRD Programmes have been organised for the benefit of **51,031** participants.

SENSITISATION PROGRAMMES

375 Sensitisation Programmes were organised to sensitise **12,581** participants during the year. The programmes were conducted to create awareness about RUDSETI to Govt. officials, Bank Managers, NGOs etc. Since inception, **4,246** Sensitisation Programmes have been organised covering **1,67,101** participants.

SHARE OF WEAKER SECTIONS

RUDSETI has been engaged in enabling unemployed rural youth to become self reliant through motivation and training without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion or economic status. However, by default, majority of our trainees are from weaker sections of the society. The composition of weaker sections in the training programmes is as follows:

TRAINING DAYS

A total number of 13,860 man-days were utilised during the year for the training, which works out to an average of 513 days per Institute.

During the conference, the performance of different units were reviewed, their unique experiences were shared and future strategies were planned. COLLABORATIONS

Collaboration of RUDSETI with developmental agencies, institutions, voluntary organizations and government departments to achieve the common objectives has proved mutually beneficial. As in the past, this year also, RUDSETI continued its fruitful association with premier organizations like NABARD, SIDBI, DIC, KVIC, DRDAs and various other State Government Departments etc.

Several Central/State Ministers, Bureaucrats and Executives from premier organizations like **RBI**, **Canara Bank**, **NABARD**, **SIDBI**, other Banks, social workers, other dignitaries from different walks of life from various parts of the country and also from South Africa visited our units. From the visits of these distinguished guests, RUDSETI has been benefitted a lot.

With strong identity under the visionary leadership of **Dr D Veerendra Heggade**, President of RUDSET Institutes, enabled by unstinted support and continued guidance from **Canara Bank**, we rededicate ourselves to mitigate the cause of the unemployment problem through undeterred confidence and motivation.

Certification was introduced to ensure uniform quality of training programmes among RSETIs. Assessment and Certification is challenging and rewarding, he concluded. After tea break, **Shri Nataraj S E**, Director, National Centre for Excellence of RSETIs, Bengaluru made power point presentation on the performance of RUDSET Institutes, Grading and CNN. He clarified the doubts raised by the participants.
