Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs

RSETIs and RUDSETIs could resume normal functioning during the Financial Year 2022-23 after facing difficulties of COVID-19 during two consecutive years 2020-21 & 2021-22. All our RSETIs/RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objectives of the RSETI movement and performed exceedingly well with regard to the number of candidates trained, settled and Credit linked during FY 2022-23. As on 31.03.2023, there are 590 RSETIs/RUDSETIs covering 572 Districts, functioning across the country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Govt. of India, which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/RUDSETIs are providing training to the Rural unemployed youth in 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. The performance highlights of the RSETIs during FY 2022-23 are as under:



- As against the Annual Target of 4.04 lakh candidates, RSETIs have totally trained 4.10 lakh candidates (Achievement being 101%), of which 3.26 lakh candidates settled (80%) and 1.93 lakh candidates have settled with Credit linkage (60%).
- RSETIs are giving priority to mobilize a greater number of rural poor unemployed youth to give training according to their requirement. Thus, out of the total trained, the share of Rural Poor trained is 3.38 lakh (82%), of which 2.67 lakh candidates have settled (79%) and 1.75 lakh have settled with Credit Linkage (62%).
- In tune with the objectives of GOI, the RSETIs/RUDSETIs are giving more emphasis for women empowerment. Thus, out of total trained, the share of women candidates trained is 3.32 lakh (81%), of which 2.73 lakh candidates have settled (82%) and 1.75 lakh women candidates settled with credit linkage (65%).

I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors, Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) of the RSETIs/RUDSETIs for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.

Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2022-23 and because of the collective efforts of the RSETIs and sponsoring Banks along with the active involvement of the State Directors (SDRs), who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with the respective Banks and SRLMs. I am pleased to inform you that the MoRD has released Rs.187.02 Crore to various states during FY 2022-23, towards settlement of the pending claims. This is the first time in the history of the RSETIs that such a big amount is released in a particular Financial Year.

Another important milestone achievement during FY 2022-23 is that the SDRs in coordination with the sponsored Banks and NIRDPR have made major get through in the matter of construction of RSETI buildings. Thus, during the year many RSETIs have shifted to own buildings, in many cases the stopped building construction was resumed, in many cases building construction was commenced, in many cases land has been allocated. I am confident that with the same tempo, the quality of the training will be greatly improved with the shifting of many more RSETIs to own building during the FY 2023-24 also.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting ToT programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training.

The grading and CNN compliance status of RSETIs has been improved gradually and during the year 2021-22, 560 RSETIs have secured AA Grade and 566 RSETIs have complied with CNN. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is publishing Annual Activity Report-2022-23. On this occasion, I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all for the performance during FY 2022-23. I am confident that your RSETI will excel performance during FY 2023-24 also.

It is hearting to learn that RUDSETI Anantapuram is coming out with its Annual Activities Report for the year 2022-23 incorporating the entire gamut of activities of the Institute. I am glad to note that RSETI has trained 843 candidates by conducting 29 programmes during FY 2022-23 against the target of 840 and achieved a Settlement rate of 72% with 51% Bank linkage. I sincerely congratulate and appreciate the commitment of Sri Lokanadha Reddy, Director and all Staff members for this wonderful performance and keeping the standards of the Institute high with excellent coordination with District administration and Sponsor Bank Management.

For a dedicated self motivated vibrant organization, it is always a pleasure to document and present systematically the performance, achievements, vis-à-vis the expectations, the efforts behind the achievements, the support from different persons and various organizations. Further it acts as guidance for future planning in order to show better performance. The preparation of **Activities Report** provides such an opportunity to us.

Our institute has entered into the **26th year** of its existence, striving to mould the unemployed youth for self reliance and assist them to establish self employment Ventures through systematic training with a combination of technical skills, behavioral inputs and managerial aspects. Over the years our Institute has earned excellent reputation as a credible entrepreneur development centre. It is not out of place to mention here that Govt. of India has adopted "**RUDSET MODEL**" and has released funds to establish Training Institutions similar to RUDSET Institute, in each district throughout India.

We have conducted **29** EDPs during the year and trained **843** candidates. During the year **604** candidates have started their own ventures with a settlement rate of **71.06%**. We have conducted **29** training programmes sponsored by NRLM.

During this year we have conducted **1** Skill Up Gradation training programme on Advanced Beauty Parlour for 32 women entrepreneurs. **22** Sensitization programmes for **670** number of officials.

Our Institute has trained **572** women under self employment programmes, which are Women's Tailor, Beauty parlor management, Vastra ChitraKala Udyami and General EDP. The share of women trainees during the year is **67.85%**. As a cost conscious of organization, we have limited our expenses within the budget allocated and at the lowest level.

INTRODUCTION

With the rapid increase in population and proportionate decline in employment opportunities both in public and private sector due to implementation of economic reforms, the unemployment problem has become the major issue of the Nation. Though there were some initiatives here and there from both Government and Non Government sectors, the results were not in tune with the efforts and investment made. Thus, due to declining openings for wage employment, youth, the most dynamic force of the country / society become desperate and restless leading to social unrest, extremism and other related social disorders.

The great visionary, **Dr.D.Veerendra Heggade ji** visualized herculean problem of unemployment and decided to do something to tackle this problem. e-SyndicateBank and Canara Bank, the two progressive banks also agreed to participate in this noble cause, led to the emergence of **RUDSET Institute** in 1982 at Ujire in D.K.District, Karnataka State. The organization grew with leaps and bounds and expanded length and breadth of our country. Today there are 27 institutes running in 17 states of India, constantly try to develop Technical as well as entrepreneurship skills in educated unemployed Rural youth to take up self employment ventures.

MISSION:

Empowering youth by motivating and training them, to take up self employment for income generation and sustained livelihood. Youth are encouraged to take part in the economic development of the society by making them self reliant and self-dependent. Youth are motivated to develop entrepreneurial qualities by building self confidence for personality development and thus eventually for the economic growth and development of the country.

TRAINING METHODOLOGY:

RUDSET Institute follow unique training methodology consisting of carefully evolved training modules to suit various programmes / courses, so that the trainees learn both technical skills as well as soft skills to become successful entrepreneurs. Basically our training programmes are short duration interventions with intensive coaching with extended hours. Unemployed youth both women and men in the age group of 19-45 years having ability to read and write local language i.e. Telugu and having aptitude to take up self employment ventures are eligible for training. Institute, besides free training also provides free residential accommodation and boarding. Thus, residential training facilitate collective learning and also enable trainees to have luxury of extended training hours whenever necessary.

Also sign White boards, Power Point presentations, motivational video clippings, simulation exercises, public address system, sophisticated computer lab, spacious class rooms with Godrej furniture and well ventilated spacious dormitory are some of the training facilities available at RUDSET Institute, Ananthapuramu. In one word "facilities of a corporate college are available for rural youth" at our Institute.

Apart from class room lectures and practicals, the training also include Field visits, interface with successful entrepreneurs, Bankers, Govt. officials etc., to make training more practical oriented. Participatory type of training is followed wherein trainees are given maximum scope to express their feelings, ideas etc., besides allowing them to interact freely with trainers. Much emphasis is on confidence building amongst the trainees. Behavioral exercises and role plays are also employed as methods to explain the concepts. Real life situations are created by simulation exercises and case studies so that the trainees can visualize the situations and help to internalize their competencies. Library facility is provided with the required study material pertaining to Hard Skills and Soft Skills. New additions are added to the library every year for the benefit of the trainees. Audio visual aids are used to supplement the class room training. Adequate training material is made available and accessible to the trainees to enable them to practice whenever the trainees are interested and inspired.

Individual counseling, follow up of the trainees for 2 years after training to help the trainees to take up self employment by maintaining rapport with financial institutions is the unique feature of post training support extended by the Institute. During the follow up, the trainees will be helped in preparation of project reports and to get financial assistance from Bank Branches.

TRAINING PROGRAMMES OFFERED:

The institute provides training in wide range of activities. All the trainings are carefully planned after scanning the environment, keeping in view the local needs and are designed with a purpose.
