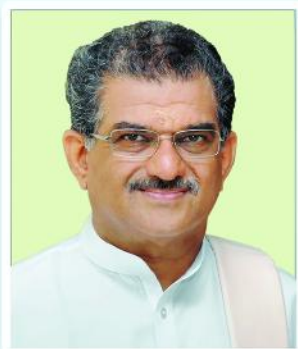

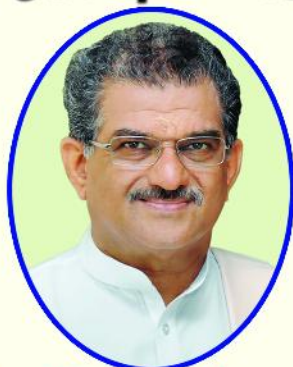

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Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs

The Financial Year (FY) 2021-22 has also seen the third wave of COVID 19 challenge. Many of our RSETIs were not able to function in a regular manner during the first quarter of the Financial Year 2021-22. In spite of the great challenge imposed by the COVID 19 / Omicron threat all our RSETIs/ RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objective of RSETIs and perform exceedingly well with regard to number of candidates trained and settled. As on 31.03.2022 there are 589 RSETIs / RUDSETIs (4 new RSETIs are added) covering 571 Districts are functioning across the Country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/ RUDSETIs are providing training to the Rural Poor on 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. As against the annual revised Target of 3.01 lakhs candidates RSETIs have trained 3.14 lakhs candidates (Achievement being 104%). Out of the above total number of Rural Poor trained is 2.82 lakhs (90%). Out of total rural poor trained 2.20 lakhs have settled (78%) and out of the rural poor settled total 1.25 Lakhs have been credit linked (59%). I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors of RSETIs and Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.

Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2021-22 because of collective efforts of RSETIs and RSETI sponsoring Banks along with the deep involvement of State Directors (SDRs) who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with SRLMs and subsequent release of Funds. In the coming days we propose to maintain the year wise position of Claims submitted, Claims rejected, Claims received and pending position in excel sheet on monthly basis at RSETIs to enable us to smoothening the claim settlement process.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting ToT programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training. In this regard, I must acknowledge the huge contribution of State Controllers of RSETIs (SCRs) and SDRs for conducting the ToT programmes in their respective States. In coming days we also propose to conduct such programmes in many states to fill the gap of certified trainers in various sectors. In this regard, we wish to highlight that there was a substantial improvement in Grading and CNN compliance position of RSETIs/ RUDSETIs in comparison to previous years. There are 541 AA Graded RSETIs and 537 CNN complied RSETIs. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is going to publish Annual Activity Report for the FY 2021-22. On this occasion I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all your Staff for your performance during the FY 2021-22. I am confident that your RSETI will excel in the FY 2022-23 under various performance parameters including Credit Linkage and Settlement.

Simultaneously, I take this opportunity to thank respected Sri Amit Kataria, IAS, Joint Secretary and Sri Virendra Sharma, Director, Ministry of Rural Development, Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Ms. A Manimekhlai, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri A Muralikrishna, GM , FI Wing, Sri Amitava Sahu, DGM and Team of FI Wing of Canara Bank, HO Bengaluru and Nodal Executives of all RSETI sponsoring Banks for their full support which has enabled us to show outstanding performance for the FY 2021-22.

At the end I advise all RSETIs/ RUDSETIs to conduct training programmes back to back without giving even a single day gap to ensure maximum number of candidates trained with regular attendance through AEBAS and also to ensure vigorous follow-up for improving the Credit Linkage and Settlement in the FY 2022-23.

RUDSET Institute in brief

Background :

Million of unemployed youth particularly from rural & semi-urban background who could not access higher professional education but oriented towards white-collar jobs are driven to despair for not finding a job. Of late, these distressed youth are attracted towards antisocial activities for their livelihood. This tremendous waste of human resources and mismatch of potentiality with productive development has baffled the planners and administrators.

Genesis :

Canara Bank, took the initiative in mitigating the unemployment problem under the leadership of Padmabhushana Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade a great visionary and a religious head of the famous pilgrim center at Dharmasthala in Karnataka. The collective thinking gave concrete shape in providing an institutional framework, in the form of RUDSET Institute in 1982 at Ujire in Dakshina Kanada district of Karnataka State. At present 27 branches are spread over the country.

Sponsors :

The Institute is jointly sponsored by Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Educational Trust, Canara Bank.

Vision Statement :

1. RUDSETI considers the youth as valuable human resource of the country to exploit the scope of availability in various avenues by launching the lucrative micro enterprise.
2. To transform youth into productive assets by short duration interventions.

Mission :

1. To channelize youth power in wealth creation through entrepreneurship.
2. To empower youth to share economic progress equitably.

Objective :

1. Identify, orient, motivate, train & assist the rural youth to take up self employment/wage employment ventures as an alternative career.
2. To take up research and development activities in Entrepreneurship and Rural Development etc.

Programme Structure :

1. **EAP** - For creating awareness among the unemployed rural youth about self Employment opportunities, one day EAP i.e. Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes have been conducted by RUDSETI, in rural areas in collaboration with local agencies i.e. Bank, Panchayat Office, Block Office, Schools, Youth clubs etc.
2. **Training** – RUDSETI offers more than 50 types of EDPs in different avenues. All the programmes are of short duration and residential training with free boarding & lodging. Duration ranging from 6 - 45 days. Mainly they are classified into four categories as shown below:

A) For First Generation Entrepreneurs :

- a) **Agriculture EDP** : Krishi Udyami, Dairy Farming & Vermi Compost Making, Goat Rearing, Poultry, Commercial Horticulture, Commercial Floriculture, Pissiculture Management, Bee Keeping, Vegetable Nursery Management & Cultivation etc.
- b) **Product EDP** : Women's Tailor, Homemade Agarabatti Maker, Jute Product Udyami, Papad, Pickle & Masala Powder Making, Soft toys Maker & Seller etc.
- c) **Process EDP** : Beauty Parlour Management, Cell phone Repairs & Service, Desktop Publicing, Computer Hardware & Networking, Electric Motor Rewinding & Repair services, LMV owner Driver, Photography & Videography, Plumbing & Sanitary Works, House Wiring, Two Wheeler servicing, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning etc.
- d) **General EDP** : EDP for PMEGP Beneficiaries, General EDP, Financial Literacy for FL-CRPs, BC Sakhi etc.

B) For the Established Entrepreneurs :

- a) **Skill Upgradation** : To improve the skills and enhance capability of the settled trainees.
- b) **Growth Programme** : To aim and achieve high goals in life & business for the settled trainees.

**Selection of candidates for the training Programme :**

Any unemployed youth in the age group of 18-45 years, irrespective of cast, creed, religion, gender and economic status, having aptitude to take up self employment or wage employment with some basic knowledge in the related field can undergo training which is totally free of cost.

Training Methodology Adopted :

1. Identification & selection of candidates
2. Campus & practical approach
3. Simulation exercises, group discussions, role plays
4. Field visits & experience sharing with role models
5. Interactions with bankers / Govt. Officials

Facilities Offered :

1. Residential training with free boarding & lodging.
2. Campus with Library & Audio Visual aids.
3. Workshop for the practical.
4. Experienced trainers motivators.
5. Exposure field / Successful business unit visit.

Follow up Service:

The cutting edge of RUDSETI training is the post training follow up for sustained motivation among the trainees. The effort to make them rise on to pinnacle includes:

1. Two Years follow up – Through regular correspondence, Individual contacts, Unit visit, village/ Taluk/ District/ Branch level meeting etc.
2. Facilitating credit linkage with the banks for setting up of micro enterprises.

Marketing Support :

RUDSETI Bazaars are organized to provide marketing support to the RUDSETI trained entrepreneurs. This facilitates the participants to get an insight about market trends and customer behavior. Each unit organizes atleast one bazaar every year during melas, exhibitions, special occasions in their command area.

Course Module:

Training modules of RUDSETI are so designed that the Entrepreneurship Development is achieved through Human Resource Development. The course modules structured out of practical experience, research and experiment facilitate development of the necessary skills in a systematic manner in a short period. The Training Modules of RUDSETI have been accepted as standard modules by Ministry of Rural Development, NIRD, SIDBI, NABARD, Department of Industries and Commerce, KSWDC etc. RUDSETI reviews these course module on an ongoing basis and revise and update them from time to time.

Recognition :

1. Received FICCI award for Rural Development for the year 1998-99.
2. Received Suvarna Karnataka Rajyotsava award for Social Service for the year 2006-07
3. The concept of RUDSETI which took birth in a small village Ujire near Dharmasthala in Karnataka has been accepted with open hands by none other than Govt. of India as a replicable model throughout the country. Ministry of Rural Development, GOI, New Delhi has directed all the nationalized Banks with lead bank responsibilities to open RUDSETI type Institutes i.e., RSETIs in all the 600 plus districts of the country and RUDSETI has been entrusted with the responsibility of giving suggestions to MORD in taking up this herculean task. This very fact in itself is a highly satisfying and a motivating factor for the Sponsors of RUDSETI.
4. Recognizing the efforts of RUDSETI in Rural Entrepreneurship Development, Ministry of Rural Development has taken the Executive Director, RUDSETI as member in National Level Steering Committee on RSETIs. 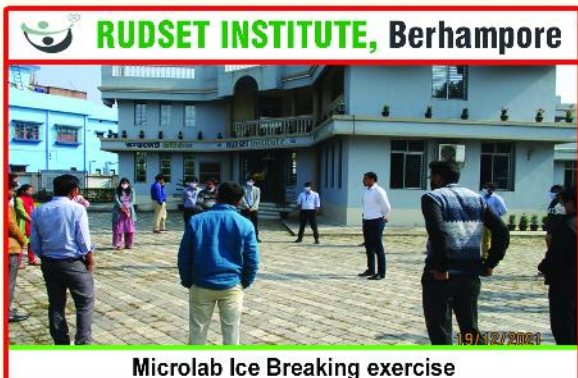
