

#### 02. BRIEF REPORT OF THE INSTITUTE

RUDSET Institute is an earnest initiative made by Padmabhushan Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade to mitigate the problem of unemployment. It was established in the year 1982. The two leading nationalized Bank viz. SyndicateBank and Canara Bank joined hands in this noble effort. The collective Thinking of Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwar Educational Trust, SyndicateBank and Canara Bank gave a concrete shape in providing an Institutional framework in form of Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institute (RUDSETI).

RUDSETI has now become a replicable model with Government of India establishing RSETIs in every district across the country, with the same pattern of education and training. Now the RSETIs have been opened in most of the Districts by the Concerned Lead Bank.

RUDSETI Bhopal is the 19<sup>th</sup> RUDSETI opened on 19<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2002. It is treated as a unique Institute, identifying, selecting, motivating and offering training to unemployed youth to take up self employment. The Institute has travelled a glorious path of 18 years and has depicted excellent performance resulting in training of 12993 youth till 31.03.2021 with 71% Settlement. The Institute has coverage over 7 Districts including Bhopal.

#### Mission:

- > Channelizing youth power in wealth creation
- > Empower youth to share economic progress equitably.

Flowers when they are in the process of blooming are not aware of their purpose of being on this earth. RUDSETI Bhopal is herewith playing an active role to make this unemployed talented youth utilize their talent by imparting them training and setting a goal for their life.

#### **Objectives:**

- > Identify, orient, motivate, train and assist the rural youth to take up self-employment /wage employment ventures as an alternative career.
- > To take up research and development activities in entrepreneurship and rural development.
- > Train village level worker to work in rural development.
- Counseling and project consultancy.

#### **Training Programmes:**

RUDSETI offers more than 60 types of Entrepreneurship Development Programmes (EDPs) in various avenues. All the programmes are of short duration intervention ranging from 10 days to 45 days.

#### a) For First Generation Entrepreneurs:

- <u>Agricultural EDPs:</u> Dairy Farming and vermi compost making, Mushroom Cultivation, commercial floriculture, Commercial Horticulture, Bee Keeping, Goat Rearing, Poultry, Gardening and Landscaping etc.
- <u>Product EDPs:</u> Women's Tailor, Men's Tailor, Homemade Agarbathi Maker, Soft Toys Maker and seller, Candle Making, Costume Jewelry Udyami, Jute Product Udyami, Papad, Pickle and Masala Powder Making, Paper Cover, Envelop and file Making etc.
- <u>Process EDPs:</u> Electrical Motor Rewinding and Repair Service, Photography & Videography, Cell Phone Repair and Service, CC TV Camera smoke detector and security alarm installation, Desktop Publishing, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, Computer Hardware and Networking, Beauty Parlour Management etc.
- General EDPs: Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme (REDP), PMEGP, EDP for Women etc.

#### b) For the Established Entrepreneurs:

- > Skill Up gradation: To improve the skills and enhance capability of the settled trainees.
- For the settled trainees. To aim and achieve high goals in life and business for the settled trainees.

#### **Rural Development and HRD Programmes:**

- > Training Rural Development Facilitators of NGOs.
- > Training in SHG Management
- > Training Bank Officials in Rural Development Activities.

#### **Generation of Applications:**

> The Institute gives wide publicity to its training programmes through print media/radio, mouth publicity of Ex. Trainees, through Sponsor Banks, Govt. Dept., NGOs and by organizing large number of Awareness Camps.

#### Eligibility of Candidate:

The candidate in the age group of 18-45 years belonging to the area of operation. I.e. resident of Sehore, Vidisha, Rajgarh, Raisen, Bhopal, Hoshangabad and Betul districts can apply for the training. The candidate who can read and write in local language, has aptitude to take up self-employment or wage employment with some basic knowledge in the related filed can undergo training, which is totally free of cost.

#### **Training Methodology:**

- Identification and Selection of Candidates.
- > Campus and Practical Approach.
- Simulation Exercises, Group Discussion, Role Plays.
- > Field Visits and Experience Sharing with Role models
- Interaction with Bankers / Government Officials

#### **Facility Offered:**

- Residential training with free Boarding and Lodging
- Campus with Library and Audio- Visual Aids
- Workshop for Practical Approach to Training
- > Experienced Trainers to train and motivate the trainees

#### Follow up:

The post training follow up of the trainees is the salient feature of the RUDSETI training, to sustain the motivational level and overcome problems faced by the trainees.

- > Two Year Follow up: Through Regular Correspondences, Door to Door visit, Branch level visit, Unit visit of the officials of the Institute etc.
- > Facilitating Credit Linkage with the banks for setting up of micro enterprises.

#### 03. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

#### **EDPs for first Generation**

- Organized 23 training programmes
- Trained 651 trainees by utilization of 338 training days
- 18 programmes were conducted exclusively for women and trained 516 women
- ❖ 581 BPL trainees trained during the year.

#### Follow up

We have conducted 94 follow up and contacted 872 candidates.

#### <u>Awareness Programme</u>

- We have Organized 75 Awareness Programmes covering 2791 youth.
- Our Institute has participated in 8 Job fairs organized by SRLM & other Govt. Departments covering 720 youth.

#### Settlement

- ❖ 464 trainees have been settled during the year with the cumulative settlement rate of 71%.
- Of which 457 trainees are settled with self-employment and 7 in wage employment.

#### **Important Events**

- **❖** We have completed 442 batches since inception and trained 12993 trainees with the settlement rate of 71%.
- ❖ We have organized 8 RUDSETI Stalls for creating awareness and publicizing RUDSETI activities.
- **❖** We have organized 2 RUDSETI Bazaars for marketing support of our trainees.

#### A. Training Programmes: - For first generation entrepreneurs

- 1. Six Agriculture EDPs were conducted and 202 trainees were trained.
- 2. Eight Product EDPs were conducted and 255 trainees were trained.
- 3. Three Process EDPs were conducted and 68 trainees were trained.
- 4. Six General EDPs were conducted and 126 trainees were trained.
- 5. Total 23 EDPs were conducted and 651 trainees were trained during the year.
- 6. Out of 23 EDPs 3 EDPs were sponsored by KVIC, Bhopal.
- 7. Out of 23 EDPs 3 EDPs were sponsored by NAR Bangaluru.
- 8. Out of 23 EDPs 20 EDPs were sponsored by SRLM Bhopal.

#### **B. Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme:-**

We have conducted 75 entrepreneurship awareness programmes during the year 2020-21 at various places. These Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes have benefited 2791 participants and helped in generating large number of applications for training needs.

#### C. Settlement: -

464 trainees were settled during the year, 386 trainees were settled by finance from Bank, 71 trainees were settled with own funds and 7 trainees were settled through wage employment. Total 9251 trainees were settled since inception. Settlement rate of our institute is 71 %.

#### D. Follow up: -

94 follow up meets were conducted and 872 trainees were contacted during the year.



#### 09. FOLLOW UP

The post training follow up is the salient feature of RUDSETI. Two year intensive, follow up of the trained candidates helps them to overcome the problems. During the year, the Institute has conducted Village level, Branch Level and Institute Level meets involving Banks and government officials to redress the grievances of trained candidates. Stress has been given to the spot visit and individual meets.
