There has been a steady growth in the Indian economy for the past many years. Though this growth has brought in development across many sectors, there are many challenges, especially in providing gainful employment to the educated unemployed, school dropouts and illiterates among the Rural unemployed youth. The employment potential in the agricultural sector, which is characterized by disguised employment and under-employment, has reached a point of stagnation. We are grateful that a well-coordinated professional effort to address this problem was made way back in 1982 by Poojya Dr D Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala in Karnataka in association with Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank to start Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institutes [RUDSETIs] to provide short term training with long term handholding to the unemployed youth.

It is indeed noteworthy that the training methodology and the best practices followed by these RUDSETIs are quite unique and this has resulted in a settlement rate of over 70%. The training methodology and the best practices followed by RUDSET Institutes have been adopted by the Ministry of Rural Development to replicate the same in all the RSETIs. The initiatives of various sponsor Banks in promoting the RSETIs has resulted in functioning of 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs as on date, providing gainful employment opportunities to many rural unemployed youths.

While the employment opportunity in Government/Public Sector is not increasing much, the growth in employment potential in Private Sector is not keeping pace with the growth in the number of youths seeking employment. With the increasing trend towards consumerism, the opportunities for Self-Employment, particularly in the Services Sector, are increasing by leaps and bounds. But the unemployed youth are not properly oriented towards Self-Employment. Consequently, they are not able to engage themselves in any productive activity and tend to become dejected in life. This is where our 591 RSETIs including 27 RUDSETIs can play a proactive role as Change Agents, orienting the unemployed youth towards entrepreneurship, imparting the required training, and providing escort services to enable them to set up their own ventures.

It is indeed a matter of pride that the RSETIs/RUDSETIs have cumulatively trained 49.4 lakh rural unemployed youth of which 35.6 lakh candidates have been settled up to 31.03.2024 i.e., above 72% settlement. The share of women candidates trained comes to above 68%. Further, the performance during FY 2023-24 is 4.51 lakh (105% achievement) in training, 3.46 lakh (77%) in settlement, and 2.08 Lakh (61%) in credit Linkage. Successful entrepreneurs have not only become self-employed but have also provided employment to a number of people in their ventures. It is noteworthy that RSETIs/RUDSETIs have played a major role in transforming the job seekers into job providers.

I am happy to note that your RUDSETI is bringing out the Annual Activity Report for FY 2023-24. I take this opportunity to extend my congratulations to the Director and Team members of the RUDSETI for their outstanding achievement in training, settlement, and Credit linkage. My gratitude to Poojya Dr D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Sri Karma Zimpa Bhutia, Joint Secretary (Skills), MoRD, Sri Santosh Kumar Tiwari, Director, MoRD, Sri. Hardeep Singh Ahluwalia, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri M. Bhaskara Chakravarthy, General Manager, FI Wing, Canara Bank, and the SRLM officials for their support and guidance from time to time.

At present 591 RSETIs are functioning in our country. These RSETIs have been opened with the promulgation of a law passed by ministry of Rural development Govt. Of India after observing successful and meaningful functioning of RUDSETIs established during 1982 at the initial stage. The Ministry of Rural Development is providing guidance through the two wings at National level like NACER (National Centre for Excellence of RSETIs) and NAR (National academy of RUDSETI). Both these institutes are having Head Quarter at Bengaluru. In each lead District at least one RSETI has been established and the lead Bank of the concerned district is engaged in running the RSETI on day-to-day basis. The expenses incurred are being reimbursed by MoRD, the claim made in this regard by Banks through the respective SRLM (State Rural livelihood Mission). The primary aim of these RSETIs / RUDSETIs is to impart vocational training of short duration to rural unemployed youth (Age Group 18 to 45 Years) so that they can be in a position to establish their own venture / business enterprise. After completion of Training Programmes hand holding support is being provided up to a period of 2 years.

Our State is having 29 RSETIs and one RUDSETI. Against the training target of 21773 candidates for the FY ending 2023-24 the State as whole achieved **101 %** comprising of 22056 candidates. Against the stipulated target of 70% settlement the State has achieved **88% settlement** ratio during the FY ending 2023-24. Similarly for the stipulated Credit Linkage of 50 % our State has achieved **70 % Credit Linkage** for the FY 2023-24.

For the above splendid achievement all the staff members of our RSETIs/ RUDSETI have worked in mission mode and are praise worthy. We congratulate all of them for their hard work and splendid achievement.

Your institute is going to publish Annual activity report for the FY 2023-24. We hope all the best in this regard.

We owe our sincere gratitude to officials of NACER, NAR, SRLM and MoRD for giving valuable advice and timely support for the smooth functioning of RSETIs/ RUDSETI in our State. Hope during the coming FY 2024-25 with the dedicated hard work, team spirit and support of all we will be in a position to achieve the allocated target in all parameters.

RUDSET INSTITUTE- A BRIEF

BACKGROUND:

Millions of unemployed youths particularly from rural and semi urban background who could not access higher/professional education, but oriented towards either secured Government jobs or private employment, are driven to despair for not getting the same. As a consequence, these distressed youth are not only attracted but also involved in antisocial activities for their livelihood. The tremendous waste of human resources and mismatch of potentiality with productive deployment of available resources has put the planners and administrators in to a difficult situation.

GENESIS:

It is under these circumstances that **RURAL DEVELOPMENT & SELF EMPLOYMENT TRAINING INSTITUTE (RUDSETI)**, a unique initiative in mitigating the unemployment problem was taken up way back in the year 1982 jointly by Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheswar Educational Trust (SDME Trust), & Canara Bank under the visionary leadership of Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Dharmasthala & Member of Parliament. The collective thinking gave concrete shape in providing institutional framework in the form of RUDSETI since 1982.

OBJECTIVE:

- ❖ Identify, Orient, motivate, train and assist the rural youth to take up self-employment ventures as an alternative career.
- ❖ To take up research and development activities in the field of entrepreneurship and rural development etc.

SERVICE OF RUDSETI:

The following services are provided in an innovative and cost-effective manner oriented with a spirit of service

- ❖ Creating awareness on self-employment opportunities.
- ❖ Developing motivation and positive attitude.
- ❖ Training to acquire hard skills & life skills.
- ❖ Hand holding for establishment and successful running of enterprise.
- ❖ Linkages with Bank for financial assistance.

MANAGEMENT:

RUDSETI is registered under Karnataka Societies Registration Act, 1860. RUDSETI is a registered trademark with a distinct logo.

The Board of Governors, consisting of Chairman & Managing Directors and the top executives of sponsor bank with Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade as the President, is the apex body to evolve strategies & take policy decisions.

The Governing council consisting of top executives from the sponsor organizations under the presidentship of Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade is another apex level body which meets periodically to monitor the progress and guide the Institutes functioning under it.

The Executive Director, a deputed officer from the sponsor bank looks after the day to day functioning of all the units and acts as a link between the sponsors and the units and convenes the apex body meetings.

Each RUDSETI is managed by a deputed officer from Canara Bank and assisted by faculties and other staff members. It is also assisted by District Level RUDSETI Advisory Committee under the Chairmanship of Collector & District Magistrate that plays the role of an advisory body, consisting of officials from Sponsors, Government Officials & eminent personalities that reviews and monitors the progress of **RUDSETI**.

RUDSETI, BHUBANESWAR

This Institute was established in the year 1999 as the 17th unit in our country. Presently the Institute is located at Bhagabanpur Industrial Estate, Patrapada, Bhubaneswar with its own campus spreading over an area of 1 acre & is equipped with well-maintained infrastructure i.e. 4 training halls, Library, Dormitories, Dining hall etc. under the grant assistance of Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India.

The Institute is having the operational area of Khordha District as RSETI, Khordha under the aegis of MORD, Govt. of India. All eligible candidates with age group of 18 to 45 years and educational qualification of minimum 8th std. may avail the facility of various NSQF aligned EDP training programme. Institute provides training, boarding & lodging and post training services completely free of cost.

The Institute also conducts area specific & need based income generation programme suitable for Self Help Groups of Khordha District under National Rural Livelihood Mission.

The Institute has been imparting training in co-ordination with various Government agencies. It is a member of various committees i.e. Block Level Bankers' Committee, District Consultative Committee, District NRLM committee, District Level Monitoring Committee (DIC), State Level Bankers' Committee functioning under State Government.
