



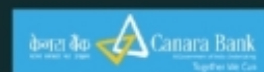

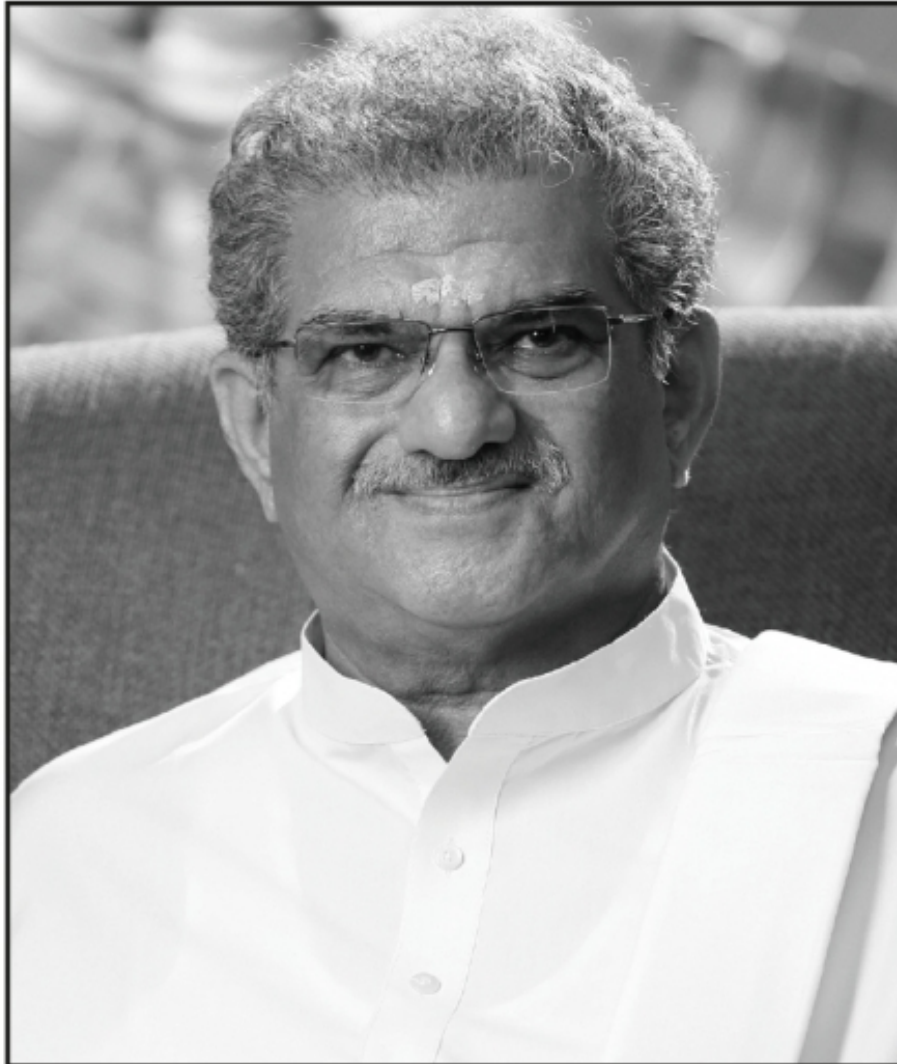

FOLLOW - UP

The post training escort services is the most distinguishing feature of RUDSETI model of training. It gives maximum importance to this function and spares considerable amount of time to follow-up the trainees for a minimum period of two years after the training. It involves coordinating with various agencies for assisting the trainees in setting up of self-employment venture. Follow-up helps the trainees to sustain motivation level and ground their projects at their earliest. The various modes of follow up are through correspondence, individual contacts, meetings at village, taluk and district levels.

During the year Institute has organized 134 follow up meets and met 1759 trainees upto March 2022. Wherever the information from the trainee is not forthcoming we are following up their progress through Bank branches.
