PREFACE

The Indian macro-economy deteriorated in financial year 2021 because of the crippling impact of COVID 19 on lives and livelihoods across the country. The triple whammy of contracting GDP, shrinking revenues and ballooning government expenditure expanded fiscal deficit of Centre and States, increased borrowing and worsened capital expenditure. The country's annual real GDP growth was estimated at (-)7.3 per cent in FY 2020-21. But with increasing vaccination, relaxed lockdown restrictions, supportive monetary and fiscal policies and stimulus packages, high-frequency indicators have been improving, growth in India is picking up and also becoming more broad-based. Clearly, then, the worst is behind us.

Against this macro-economic background and financial landscape, RUDSETI has been striving to do their best to alleviate, to a limited extent, the hardships of the people. The Gurugram unit, which was established on August 4, 1984, has performed commendably in contributing its mite in developing skill and thus creating gainful employment opportunity for the unemployed youth.

It is gratifying to note that RUDSETI has been able to deliver what was then expected from the promoters of the Institutes. In the past 37 years, it has grown to 27 units of RUDSET Institute located in 17 different states. The Gurugram unit was established on 04.08.1984. Management

The Board of Governors consisting of Chairman and Managing Directors of sponsor banks and the top executives from the sponsoring organizations with Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade as the President is the apex body to evolve strategies and take policy decisions.

The Governing Council consisting of top executives from the sponsor organizations under the Presidentship of Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade is another apex level body which meets periodically to monitor the progress of all the units and advise the units of RUDSETI.

The executive Director, a deputed officer from the sponsor bank looks after the day to day functioning of all the units.

Each RUDSETI is assisted by 'District level RUDSETI Advisory Committee' (DLRAC) an advisory body with the representatives of sponsor organizations, Government officials and eminent personalities. It periodically reviews and monitors the progress of RUDSETI.

Each unit is managed by one deputed officer from sponsor banks.

Objective

- To identify, Orient, Motivate, Train and Assist the rural unemployed youth to take up self employment ventures.
- To take up research and development activities in Entrepreneurship and Rural Development.
- Train village level workers to work in rural development.
- Counseling and project consultancy.

Programme Structure

RUDSETI offers more than 56 types of EDPs in various avenues. All the programmes are of short duration intervention ranging from 10 days to 45 days.

1. Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) for first Generation Entrepreneurs

- **Agricultural EDPs:**

Comprehensive Agriculture and Allied Activities, Dairy Farming and Vermi Compost Making, Commercial Horticulture / Floriculture, Sheep / Goat Rearing, Poultry, Cultivation of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants, Rubber tapping and processing, Piggery, Bee keeping etc.

- **Product EDPs:**

Homemade Agarbatti Maker, Paper Cover, Envelop and File Making, Men's Tailor, Costume Jewellery Udhyaami, Soft toys, Papad, pickle and masala powder making, Women's tailor.

- **Process EDPs:**

Photography and Videography, Cell Phone Repairs and service, Beauty Parlour Management, Two wheeler mechanic, Electric motor rewinding & repair services, LMV owner driver, Gharelu Vidyuth upkaran sewa udyami, T V technician, Computerized accounting, Fast Food stall Udyami, Desk top publishing, Computer Hardware, Refrigeration and Air conditioning etc.

- **General EDPs:**

Business correspondent and Business facilitator, Debt recovery agent.

EDP for PMEGP CANDIDATES.

Growth Programme:

To aim and achieve high goals in life and business for the settled trainees.

Rural Development & HRD Programmes:

Training to Rural Development Facilitators of NGOs, Training in SHG Management, Training Bank Staff in Rural Development activities and training to social animators.

Technology Transfer Programme:

To transfer the latest technologies which are cost effective and eco-friendly in agriculture and other areas.

Training Methodology

- Identification and Selection of candidates
- Campus and Practical approach.
- Simulation exercises, Group discussions, Role plays.
- Field visits and Experience sharing with role models.
- Interactions with Bankers/Govt. officials.

Facilities Offered

- Residential training with free boarding and lodging.
- Campus with Library and Audio-Visual aids.
- Workshop for the practical.
- Experienced trainers/motivators.

Eligibility Criteria to get into RUDSETI Programmes

For the First Generation Entrepreneurs Youth having aptitude to take up self employment in the age group of 18-45 years, who can read and write local language.

Criteria for RD, HRD and Technology Programmes are determined in consultation with the programme sponsors.

Escort Services

The cutting edge of RUDSETI training is the Post Training Programme follow-up, for sustained motivation among the trainees. The efforts to make them rise on to pinnacle includes:

- Two years follow-up, regular correspondences, Individual contacts, Units visit, Village/Taluk/District/Branch Level Meeting, Special follow-up meeting involving Bankers/Govt. Officials.
- Facilitating Credit linkage with the banks for setting up of micro enterprises.
- Business linkage, Workshops, Seminars, etc.

What sets RUDSETI apart?

- Visionary leadership provided by Dr. D Veerendra Heggade supported by two leading Nationalized Banks viz. SyndicateBank and Canara Bank.
- Free training with free food and accommodation.
- Campus approach with unique training methodology.
- Short term training with long term follow up / Escort Services for a period of two years.
- Variety of training programmes to suit the local needs.
- Practical orientation, rigorous training and extended hours of learning.
- Post trainees becoming trainers and imparting training.
- High settlement rate of trained youth.
- Settled trainees earning in the range of Rs. 5,000 to 50,000 per month.
- Employment Generation in the range of 1 to 50 persons by settled trainees.

Marketing Support

RUDSET Bazaars are organized to provide marketing support to the RUDSETI trained entrepreneurs.

This facilitates the participants to get an insight about market trends and customer behaviors.

Each unit organizes at least one bazaar every year during melas, exhibitions, and special occasions.

RUDSETI conducts National Level Exhibition cum sales at Dharmasthala every year during “Laksha Deepotsava” during November-December. The trained entrepreneurs from the units of RUDSETI participate in the event. Our Gurugram unit is also participating in India International Trade Fair, New Delhi every year which provides a platform for our settled trainees to exhibit their products.

Consultancy

RUDSETI model of Rural Entrepreneurship Development has been found worth emulating. RUDSETI has become brand name in the field of rural entrepreneurship and caught the attention of RBI, Union and State Government, NABARD, SIDBI etc. The methodology and results of RUDSETI have motivated Banks, NGOs, and Government to advocate and replicate the model of RUDSETI in various corners of the country. In this regard, RUDSETI offers Consultancy services to establish similar Institute by entering into MOU with the NGOs, Banks etc.

Programme for Entrepreneurship Development Facilitators

National Level Trainer's Programme is an annual event in the diary of RUDSETI. Every year, it is conducted in the month of August at Dharmasthala, Karnataka State, for the benefit of entrepreneurship development facilitators. Nationalised banks and NGOs avail this opportunity to get their officers trained in entrepreneurship development. Both the Chairman & Managing Directors of Canara Bank and SyndicateBank and Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade participate in inaugural/valedictory function of this programme.

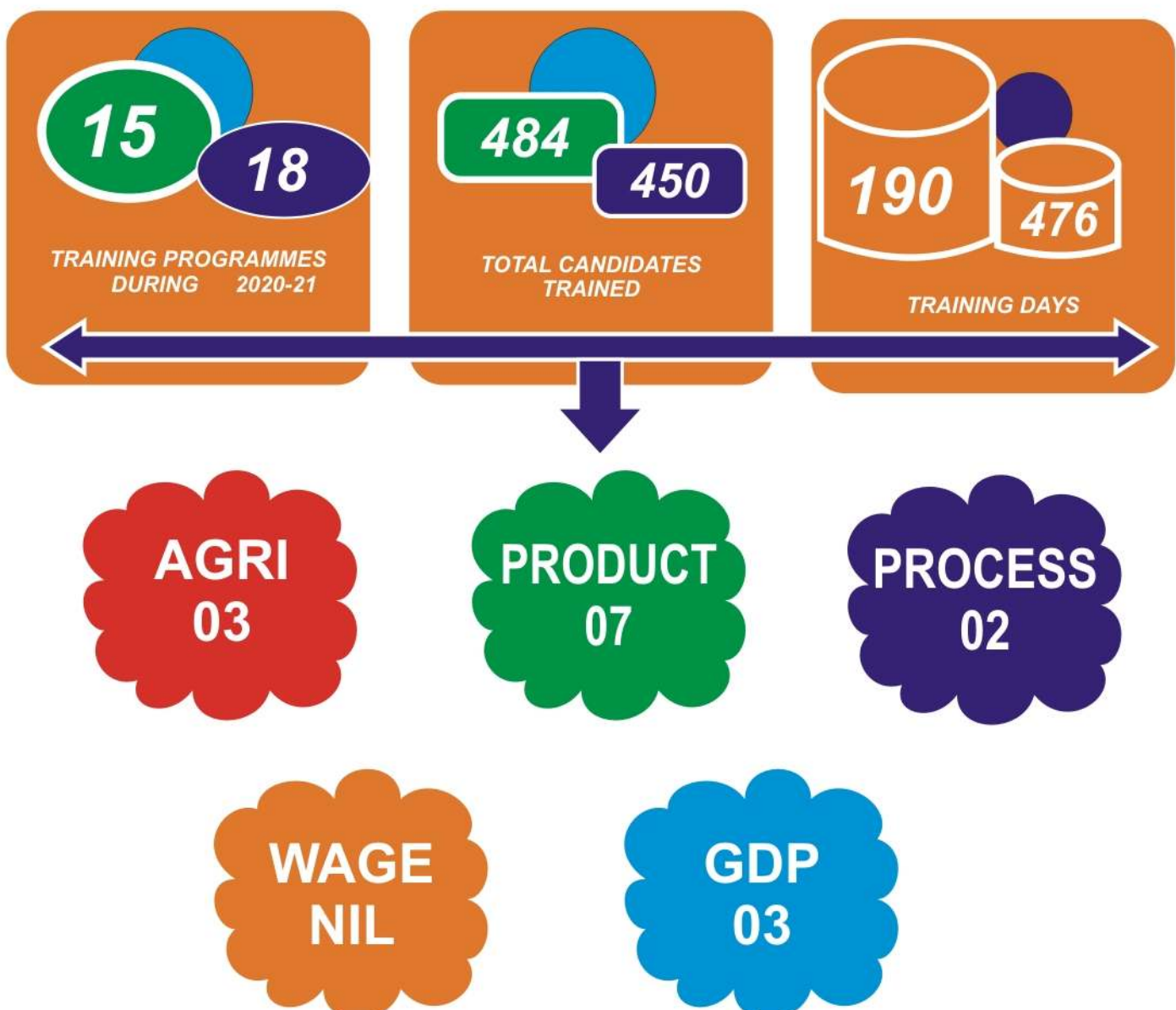

Maintaining all COVID-19 protocols, with support from all villages. Team RUDSET Conducted 14 programed in different villages particulars for SHG women out at 484 Candidates trained in 20-21.

Entrepreneurship Development Programme:

Our Institute achieved following targets set by OUR PRIME MOVERS.



During current financial year 2020-21, 15 training programmes were conducted which constitutes 3 **AGRI EDP, 7 PRODUCT EDP, 2 PROCESS EDP, 3 GENERAL EDP.**

Training programmes conducted were mix of traditional activities like Jute Products, fast food, , Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, Beauty Parlour Management etc

Needless to mention that these trainings were in tune with latest and upgraded technology e.g. Engineers from Bajaj Auto Ltd. were invited to train Two Wheeler Servicing trainees.

During the financial year Five hundred Thirty Four (534) candidates were empowered to start micro enterprises / take up job employment.

SKILL UPGRADATION PROGRAMME:

To upgrade the skills of our ex-trainees who have already established their self employment ventures.

BUSINESS AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT:

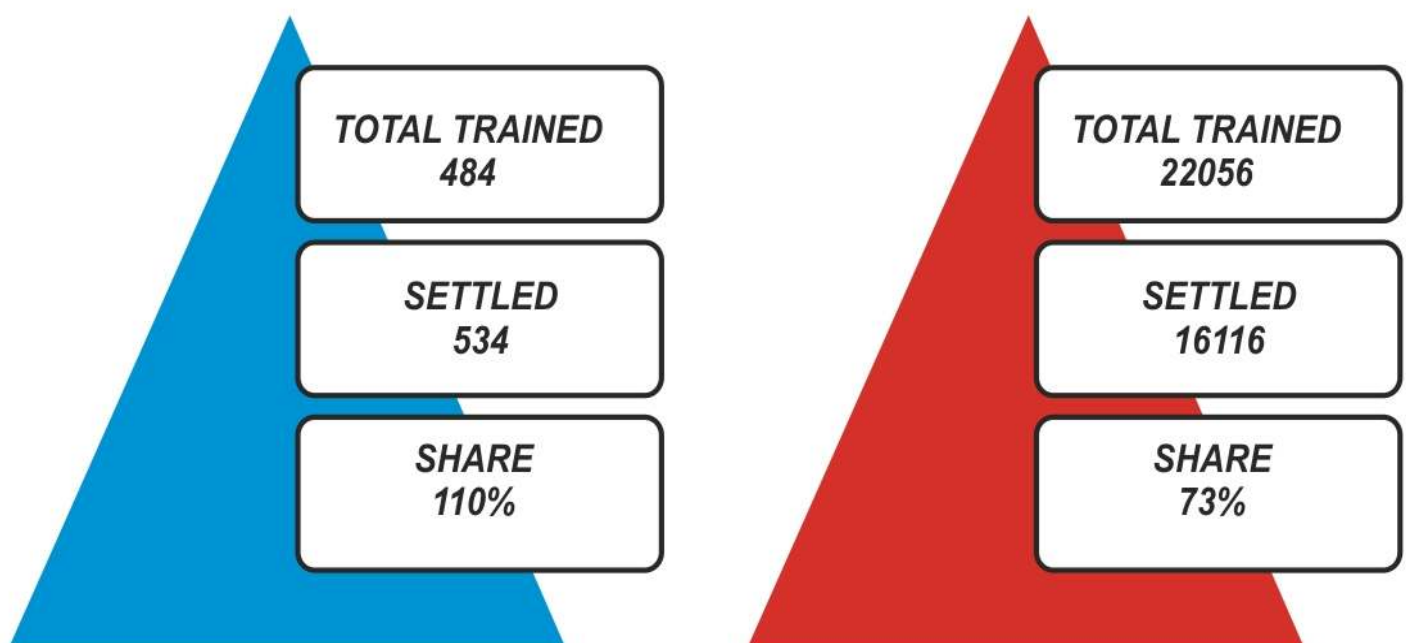
During this long journey of 36 years from 1984 to 2021, our Institute is catering services to appx 700 candidates per year.

This number has enabled us to attain distinct position as EDP Institute in the State of Haryana.

SETTLEMENTS:

The success of entrepreneurship training lies in the actual starting of the self-employment venture by the trainees or taking up the job employment.

During this year 2020-21, 534 candidates were able to start their own ventures . We are proud to say that right from our inception, 16116 out of 22056 trained candidates have been settled either by self employment or wage employment which is 73% for our Institute. During the year 326 candidates were given financial help by bank branches to the tune of Rs.182.26 lakhs. Since inception Institute assisted 4981 candidates in securing bank finance aggregates over Rs. 5632.58 lakhs.

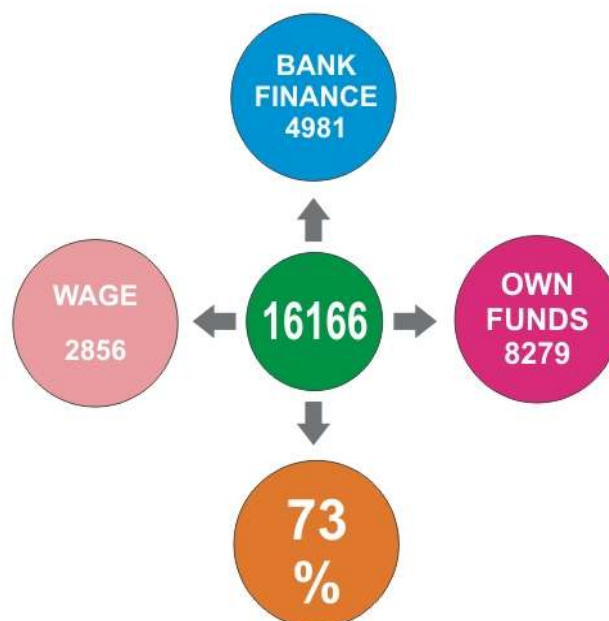

DURING THE YEAR 2020-21



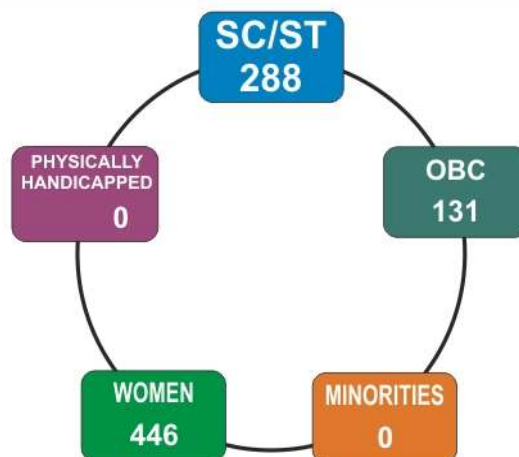
SINCE INCEPTION I.E FROM 04.08.1984

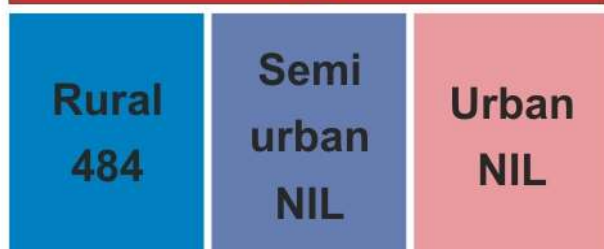

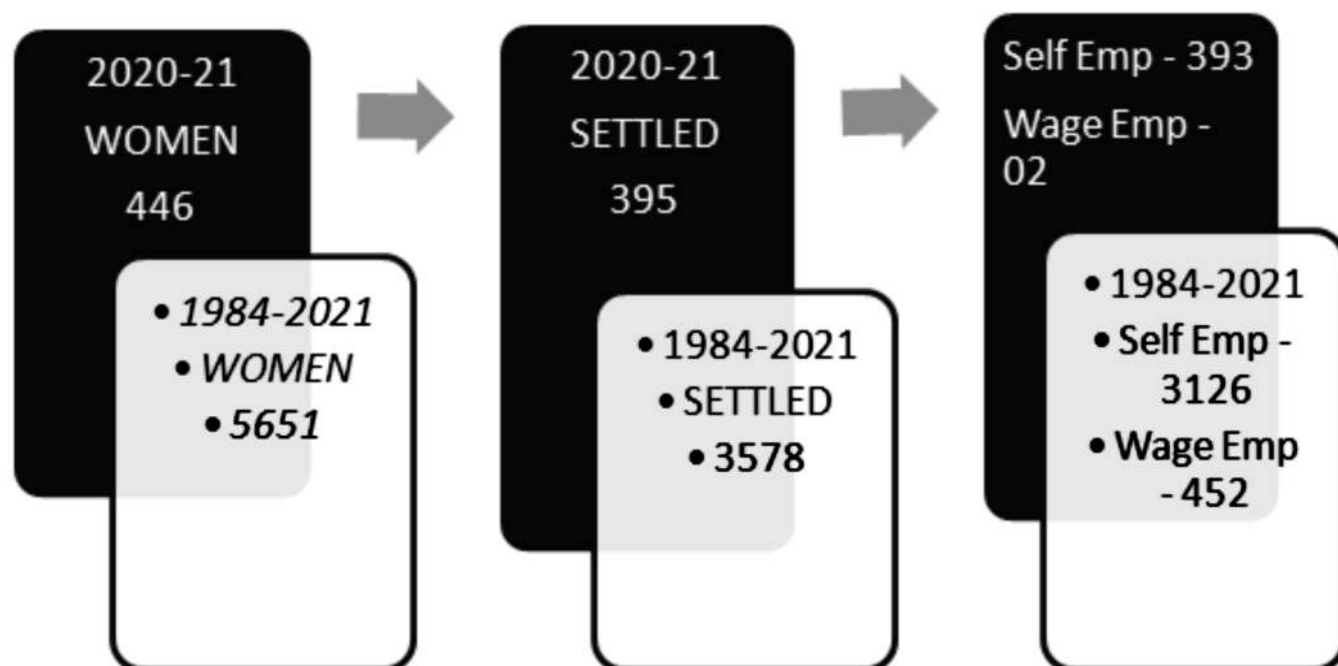
WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:

One hundred one (259) women got credit linkage to the tune of Rs 165.47 lacs during the year.

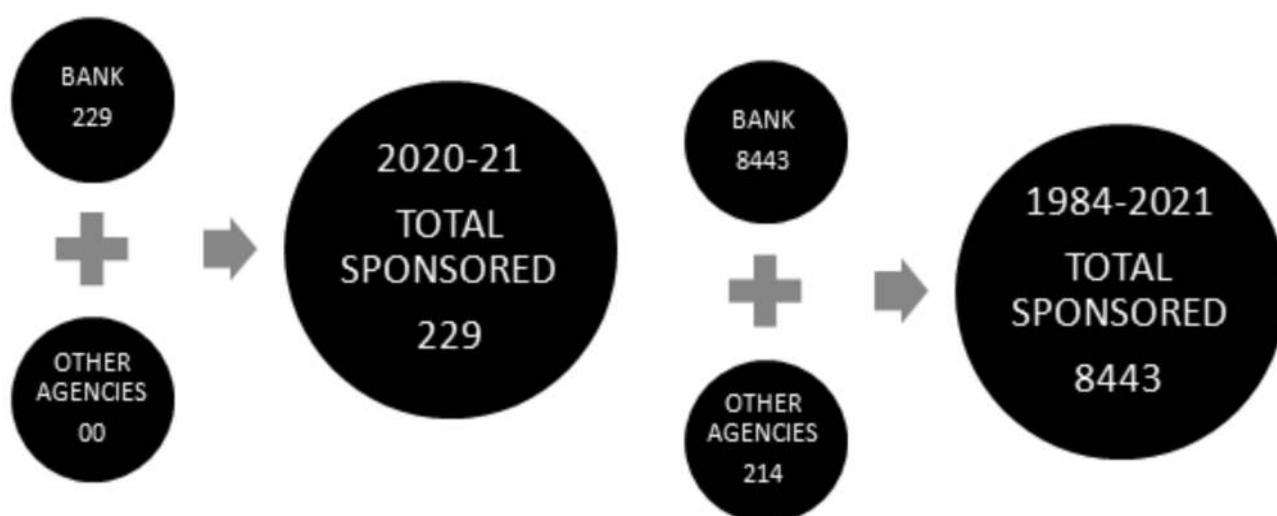
The total numbers of women trained by the Institute since inception are 5205 out of which 3183 have started their enterprises and 450 opted wage employment.
