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Message

Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs

The Financial Year (FY) 2021-22 has also seen the third wave of COVID 19 challenge. Many of our RSETIs were not able to function in a regular manner during the first quarter of the Financial Year 2021-22. In spite of the great challenge imposed by the COVID 19 / Omicron threat all our RSETIs/ RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objective of RSETIs and perform exceedingly well with regard to number of candidates trained and settled. As on 31.03.2022 there are 589 RSETIs / RUDSETIs (4 new RSETIs are added) covering 571 Districts are functioning across the Country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/ RUDSETIs are providing training to the Rural Poor on 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. As against the annual revised Target of 3.01 lakhs candidates RSETIs have trained 3.14 lakhs candidates (Achievement being 104%). Out of the above total number of Rural Poor trained is 2.82 lakhs (90%). Out of total rural poor trained 2.20 lakhs have settled (78%) and out of the rural poor settled total 1.25 Lakhs have been credit linked (59%). I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors of RSETIs and Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.



Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2021-22 because of collective efforts of RSETIs and RSETI sponsoring Banks along with the deep involvement of State Directors (SDRs) who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with SRLMs and subsequent release of Funds. In the coming days we propose to maintain the year wise position of Claims submitted, Claims rejected, Claims received and pending position in excel sheet on monthly basis at RSETIs to enable us to smoothening the claim settlement process.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting To Programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training. In this regard, I must acknowledge the huge contribution of State Controllers of RSETIs (SCRs) and SDRs for conducting the To Tprogrammes in their respective States. In coming days we also propose to conduct such programmes in many states to fill the gap of certified trainers in various sectors. In this regard, we wish to highlight that there was a substantial improvement in Grading and CNN compliance position of RSETIs/ RUDSETIs in comparison to previous years. There are 541 AA Graded RSETIs and 537 CNN complied RSETIs. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is going to publish Annual Activity Report for the FY 2021-22. On this occasion I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all your Staff for your performance during the FY 2021-22. I am confident that your RSETI will excel in the FY 2022-23 under various performance parameters including Credit Linkage and Settlement.

Simultaneously, I take this opportunity to thank respected Sri Amit Kataria, IAS, Joint Secretary and Sri Virendra Sharma, Director, Ministry of Rural Development, Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Ms. A Manimekhlai, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri A Muralikrishna, GM, FI Wing, Sri Amitava Sahu, DGM and Team of FI Wing of Canara Bank, HO Bengaluru and Nodal Executives of all RSETI sponsoring Banks for their full support which has enabled us to show outstanding performance for the FY 2021-22.

At the end I advise all RSETIs/ RUDSETIs to conduct training programmes back to back without giving even a single day gap to ensure maximum number of candidates trained with regular attendance through AEBAS and also to ensure vigorous follow-up for improving the Credit Linkage and Settlement in the FY 2022-23.

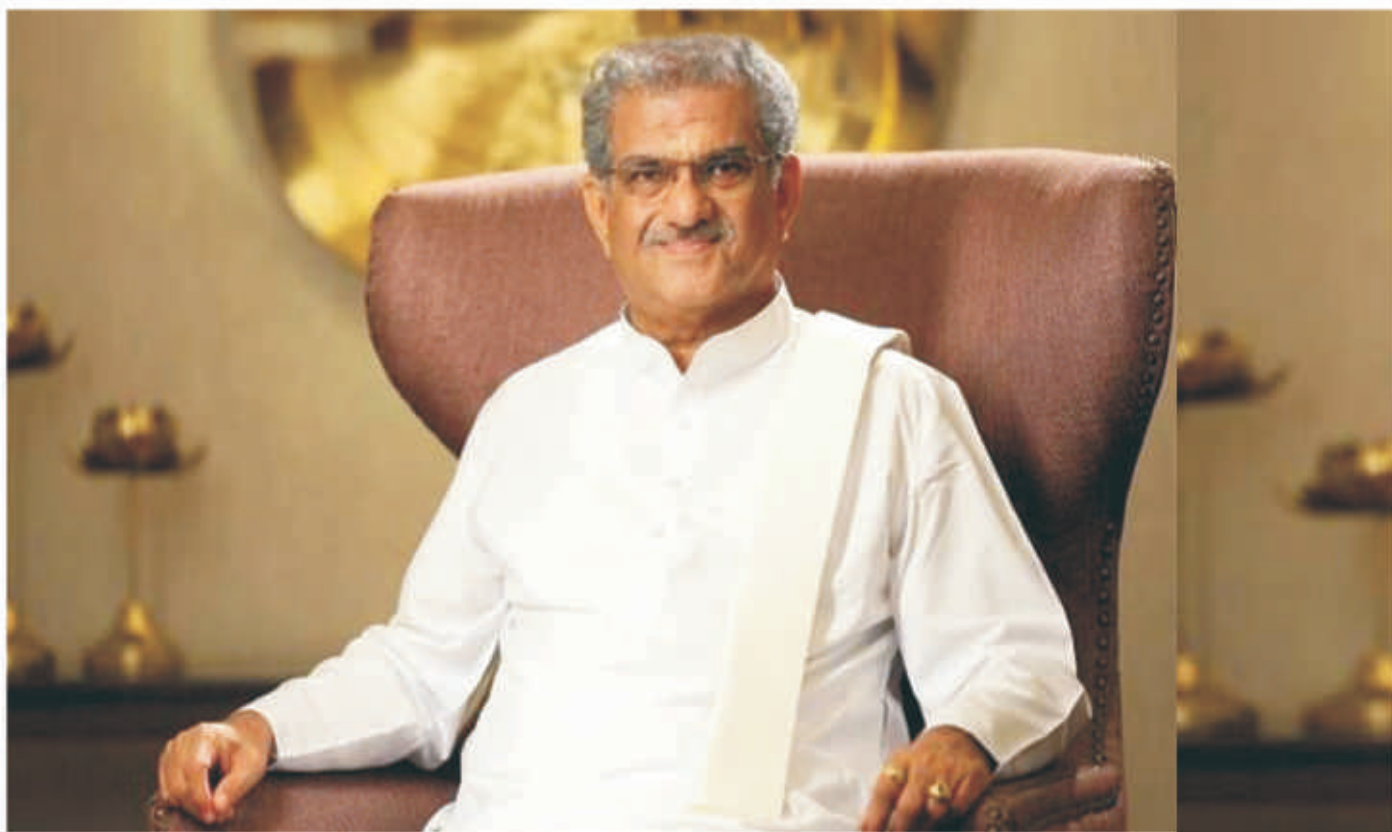

← **PREFACE** →

The Indian macro-economy improved in financial year 2022 after crippling impact of COVID 19 on lives and livelihoods across the country. The triple whammy of contracting GDP, shrinking revenues and ballooning government expenditure expanded fiscal deficit of Centre and States, increased borrowing and worsened capital expenditure. But with the increase in providing the vaccination, relaxed lockdown restrictions, supportive monetary and fiscal policies and stimulus packages, high-frequency indicators have been improving, growth in India is picking up and also becoming more broad-based. Clearly, then, the worst is behind us. The country's annual real GDP growth was estimated at 8.7% in FY 2021-22 above pre pandemic level

On unemployment front, Rural India has been affected more as compared to Urban. Unemployment level in Haryana was 24.6% which is almost highest in country against this macro-economic background and financial landscape, RUDSETI has been striving to do their best to alleviate, to a limited extent, the hardships of the people. The Gurugram unit, which was established on August 4, 1984, has performed commendably in contributing its mite in developing skill and thus creating gainful employment opportunity for the unemployed youth, with full support from District Administration & HSRLM.

We are very well-versed and fully conscious of the needs of the society at this difficult juncture particularly due to covid-19 and the huge expectations from the RUDSET Institute. 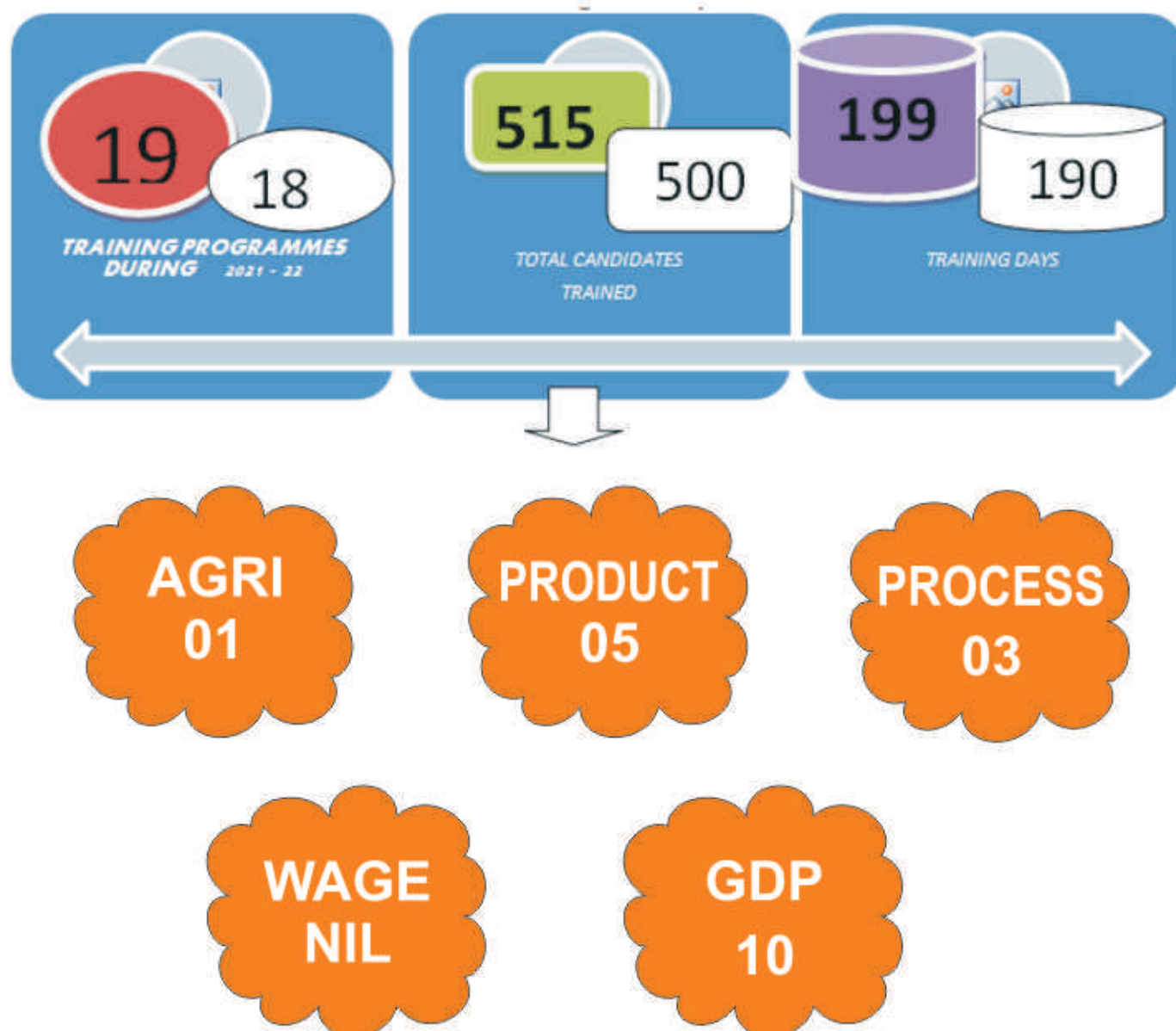

BUSINESS AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT:

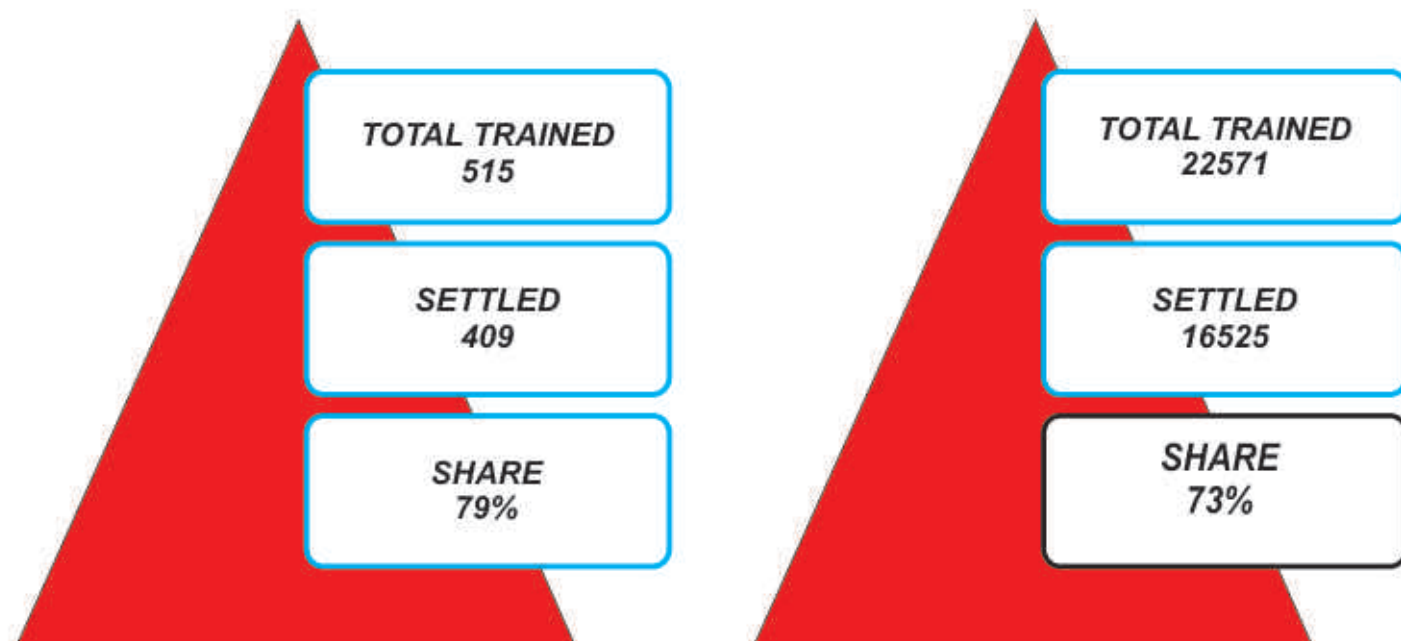
During this long journey of 37 years from 1984 to 2022, our Institute is catering services to appx 700 candidates per year.

The success of entrepreneurship training lies in the actual starting of the self-employment venture by the trainees or taking up the job employment.

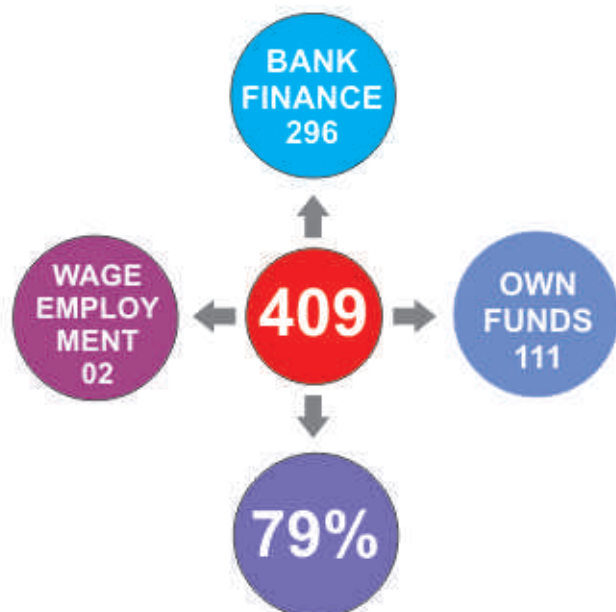
During this year 2021-22, 409 candidates were able to start their own ventures. We are proud to say that right from our inception, 16525 out of 22571 trained candidates have been settled either by self employment or wage employment which is 73% for our Institute. During the year 296 candidates were given financial help by bank branches to the tune of Rs.95.74 lakhs. Since inception Institute assisted 5277 candidates in securing bank finance aggregates over Rs. 5728.32 lakhs.



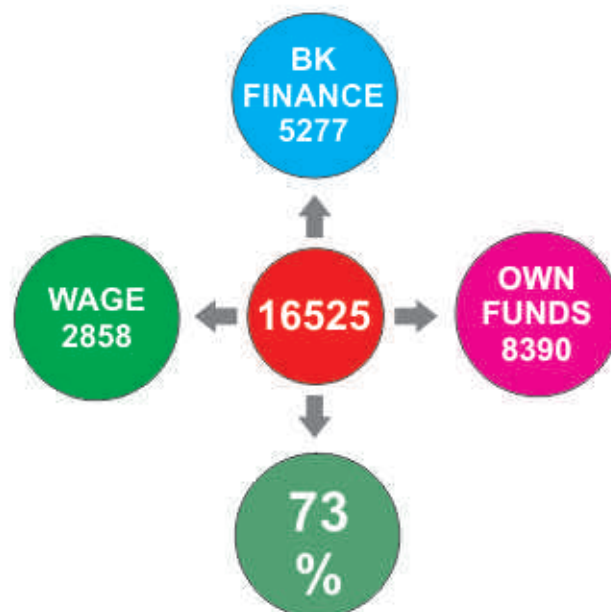
During the year **296** candidates were given financial assistance of **Rs 95.74** lacs by bank branches.

DURING THE YEAR 2021-22



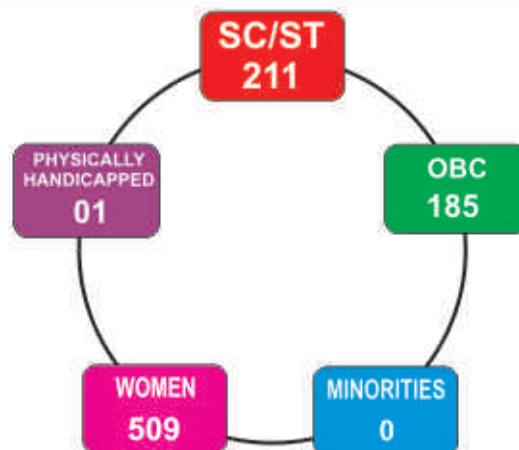
SINCE INCEPTION I.E FROM 04.08.1984

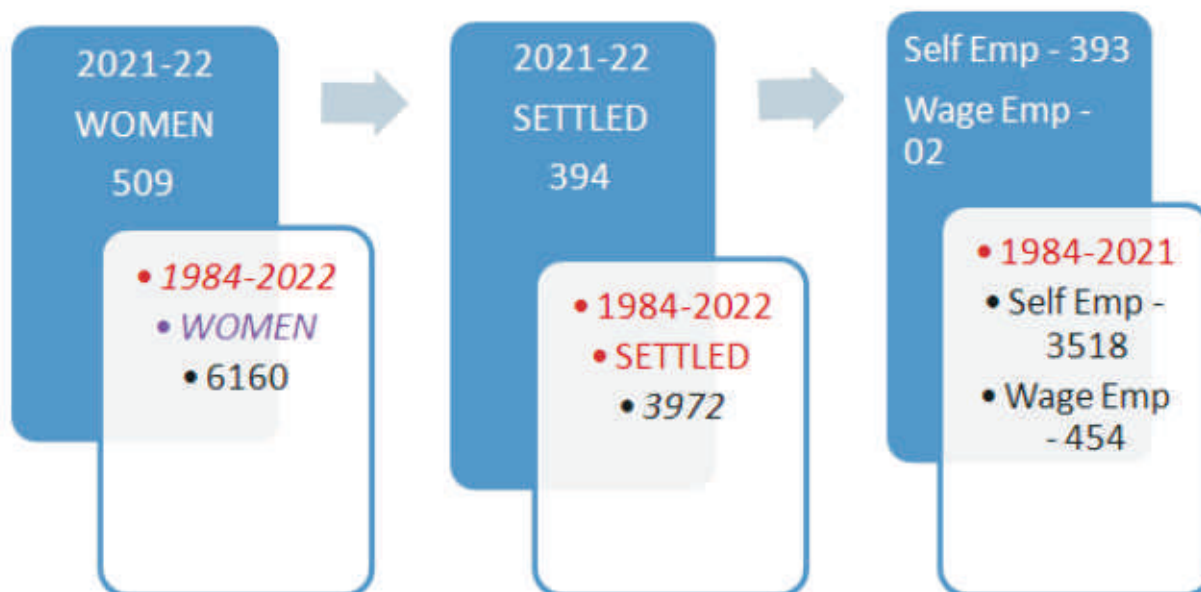
WOMEN EMPOWERMENT:

To promote women entrepreneur, 509 women were given training in various self employment activities during current financial year.

394 women were able to reap the benefits and either started their self-employment ventures (02) or took the job employment (2).

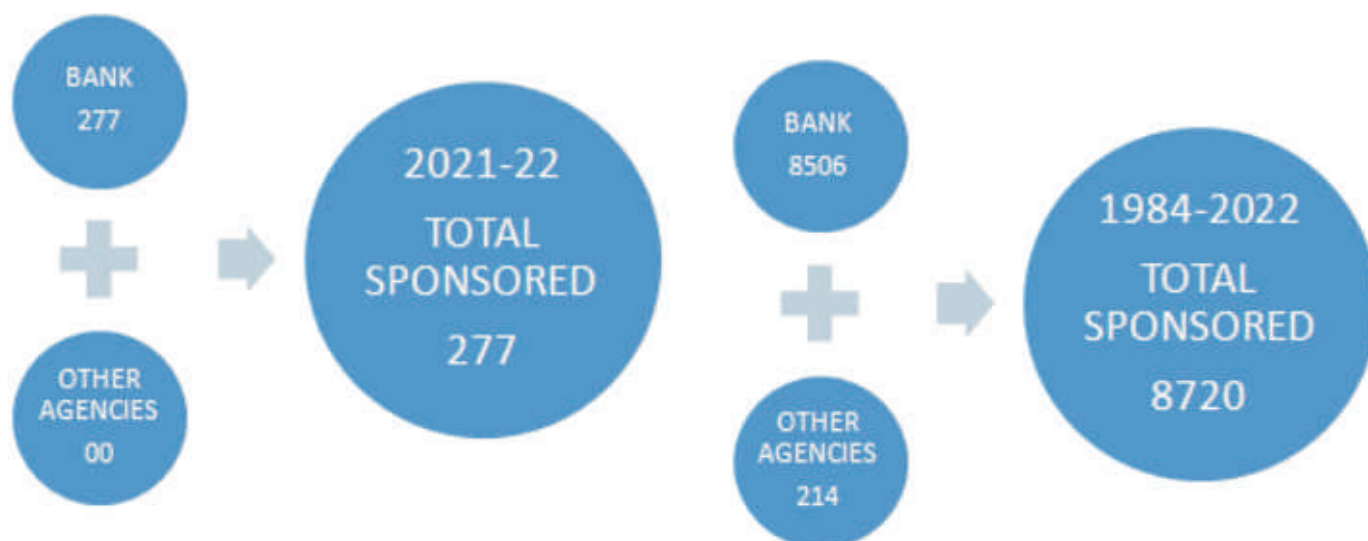
295 women got credit linkage to the tune of Rs 95.49 lacs during the year.

The total numbers of women trained by the Institute since inception are 6160 out of which 3972 have started their enterprises and 454 opted wage employment.



SPONSORSHIP

277 candidates were sponsored by various Bank branches and other agencies during the year. The cumulative number of sponsored candidates has become 8720.



ESCORT SERVICES

The cutting edge of RUDSETI training is the post training follow-up to sustain motivation level and to overcome teething problems of new enterprises. During this year we could contact 1704 candidates out of which through personal contacts in 162 spot meets.

199 training days were utilized during this year to train 515 candidate in 19 programmes. In its addition

ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

93EAP Camps were organized during current year to reach 5159 un employed youth. These camps were organized to motivate unemployed youth to take up self employment ventures. Various agencies like Bank branches, NGOs like Nehru Yuva Kendra, Animal Husbandry Deptt, Agriculture Deptt. of Haryana Govt., Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Local authorities were associated.

In its addition, 24 Sensitization programmes were also organized for 910 executive & officials.

Recurring Expenditure during the year was Rs. 33.85 lakhs as against Rs.73.64 lakhs spent last year. I am proud to say that our institute is creating entrepreneurs with wider visions who think big and ready to leap in present scenario.
