

#### **RUDSET Institute – An over view**

Syndicate Bank and Canara Bank the two broad-minded banks took the initiative in mitigating the unemployment problem under the leadership of Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, a great visionary and religious head of the famous pilgrim centre Dharmasthala in Karnataka. The collective thinking gave tangible shape in providing an institutional framework, in the form of Rural Development and Self Employment Training Institute (RUDSETI) in 1982 at Ujire, a small village in South Canara District in Karnataka.

Encouraged by the success of Ujire experiment, RUDSETI has now established 27 units spread over 17 states in India.

#### **MISSION**

- 1. Channelizing youth power for wealth creation.
- 2. Empower youth to share economic progress equitably.

#### **PHILOSOPHY**

Transformation of rural youth to acquire productive identity through short duration intervention. This is achieved by bringing technology, training and credit within their reach, utilizing little experience gained in their life.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- 1. Identify, orient, motivate, train and assist the rural youth to take up self-employment ventures as an alternative career.
- 2. Promote rural entrepreneurship.
- 3. Train village level workers.
- 4. Counselling and project consultancy.

#### **MANAGEMENT**

The Board of Governors consisting chief executives of sponsor organizations is the supreme policy making body. The "Governing Council" with 'Executive Director', an officer deputed by sponsor banks aids 'The Board of Governors' in monitoring RUDSETI. Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President of 'Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Educational Trust' is the President of the 'Board of Governors' as well as 'Governing Council'. Each RUDSETI has a 'District Level RSETI Advisory Committee' (DLRAC) with representatives of sponsor organizations, government officials and eminent personalities.

#### **FOLLOW UP**

The post training follow up of the trainees is the salient feature of the RUDSETI training, to sustain the motivational level and overcome problems faced by the trainees.

#### RUDSETI APPROCH IN DEVELOPING ENTREPRENEURS.

- a. Carefully designed selection process to identify and select only the interested and potential youth, taking in to account their interest and aptitude.
- b. Suitably designed programme schedules keeping in view the absorption level and future requirements of the candidate.
- c. Use of practical learning, group discussion, and field level experience and participation methods to impart training.
- d. Use of market survey, interface with entrepreneurs and other techniques to acquaint trainee with field level situation.
- e. Close and systematic follow up and monitoring system after the training so as to provide post training Counselling, support and liaison service.

#### **Training Programme**

The Institute has evolved need based specific training programmes for first generation entrepreneurs and also programmes for established entrepreneurs. The Institute conducts different types of short duration EDP programmes ranging from one to six weeks.

#### **Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme**

RUDSET Institute conducts EAP to sensitize the youth towards Self-employment as a strong and superb career in collaboration with Govt. departments, NGO's, Voluntary organizations and Banks as a pre training activity.

#### **Generation of Applications**

The Institute gives wide publicity to its training programmes through print media, visual media, Radio, apart from sponsor banks, Govt. Departments, NGOs. Online applications are generated through our website www.rudset.com and using Google forms promoted via Social Media.

#### **Eligibility of Candidates**

The candidates belonging to the area of operation, falling under the category of BPL and who can read and write Malayalam in the age group of 18 to 45 are eligible for any training programme.

#### **Selection of Candidates**

Institute has adopted a scientific tool called 'focused behavioural event interview technique in respect of all training programmes particularly of skill oriented programmes except for agricultural EDPs where selection can be done on the basis of information in the application form itself.

#### The training programmes are classified under the following categories

#### 1. For First generation Entrepreneurs:

Agricultural EDPs like - Dairy, Poultry, sustainable agriculture, bee keeping etc.

- a. Product EDPs like Dress Designing, stained Glass etching etc.
- b. Process EDPs like servicing / repairs of electrical / electronic equipment, pump set repairs, photography etc.
- c. General EDP programmes for establishing and managing general Business enterprises.

#### 2. For Established Entrepreneurs:

- a. Skill Up gradation programme for enhancing the skills.
- b. Growth Programmes for expansion, diversification and growth in business.

- c. Rural Development training programmes for Rural Development Workers of NGOs, SHG representatives, staff of rural banks and social animators, Farmers.
- d. Technology transfer programmes for introduction of cost efficient, environment friendly technology like Coconut tree climber appliances. Etc.
- e. Human Resources Development programmes for officials of banks, Govt. Departments, NGOs and cooperative establishments.

#### About RUDSET Institute, Kannur.

RUDSET Institute, Kannur - the only RUDSET Institute in Kerala was originally established in the year 1985 at Maipady in Kasaragod district, catering to the needs of the unemployed youth in Kasaragod, Kannur, Wayanad districts and Mahe region. In 1994 the Institute was shifted to a rented building at Kannapuram, in Kannur District. In the year 2011 the institute was shifted to its own campus at Kanhirangad, Near Taliparamba. The same was inaugurated on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2012 by Sri K C Joseph, then Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development, Govt of Kerala with the noble presence of our president Dr D Veerendra Heggadeji. The present building is the result of financial support given by Ministry of Rural Development [MoRD], Govt of India and our sponsors. The Institute is currently managed by Sri. Arun K P, Senior Manager, on deputation as Director from our one of the esteemed sponsor organizations, Canara Bank.

#### RD PROGRAMME FOR THE INMATES OF CENTRAL PRISON KANNUR

As part of correctional administration the department of prisons and correctional services, Government of Kerala decide to impart self-employment training programme to the inmates of various prisons in kerala. RUDSET Institute, Kannur conducted one Rural Development training programme on Fast Food which



includes making of Bread, Puffs, Rolls, Samoosa etc. to the inmates of Central Prison Kannur. Central Prison Kannur will be assisted by RUDSET Institute, Kannur as knowledge consultant to launch branded Bread and Biscuits just like branded Chapathis, Chips launched by Central Prison Kannur. The programme commenced on 21.03.2022 and ended on 26.03.2022. 15 candidates participated in the programme. Sri Jayakumar V, Superintendent In Charge of Central Prison Kannur inaugurated the programme.

#### **UNNATI TRAINING PROGRAMMES**

As part of offering training programmes for UNNATI Candidates who have completed 100 working days under MGNREGS, we have conducted three off campus programme at Panoor, Peravoor and Chitariparamba of Kannur Districts. We organised General EDP on Baker



and Pastry at Panoor and Peravoor and Chitariparamba. A total of 74 candidates benefited out of these three off campus training programme.

In order to promote good food and a healthy life and promoting village level self-employment especially among house wives RUDSET Institute, Kannur initiated Rural Development programme by imparting Mushroom Cultivation. The Institute Organised 3 RD programmes on Mushroom Cultivation in association with different NGOs and Organisations. Mushroom is a good food with lots of healthy benefits. Mushroom Cultivation can be learned easily and it has a good market. At the same time no good products are available in the market also so that people can buy and use it. 




