Our Madurai unit of RUDSETI started on 02.02.1987 and at that time it was the first and the only RUDSET institute in the state. Since its inception the institute has trained 25380 numbers of peoples and the settlement percentage is 77%, which is higher than the national average of 70%.

I am happy to note that RUDSETI, Madurai is the first CNN (Common Notification Norms) complied institute in Tamilnadu. The training programme was charted out based on the need and opportunity available from the 13 blocks of Madurai, with the co-ordination of line departments such as Department of Rural Development and Tamilnadu State Rural Livelihood Mission (TNSRLM).

After Covid lockdown, the Institute has restarted physical training from the month of July. The efficient team of staffs and The Director worked scrupulously, following covid protocol and achieved this year Annual Target.

Special training program for the Jail Inmates and opening savings bank accounts for them are excellent mile stone.

Out of the total 644 trainees trained this year, 391 trainees are women. The institute concentration on women empowerment in MSME sector is commendable.

The post training works such as Credit Linkage has improved substantially. The "RUDSETI BAZAAR" organized for the ex- trainees are very much visible to help in marketing their products and services.

I am sure it all has happened only with good liaison and co-ordination with line departments. I sincerely thank each and every stake holders who has extended their support to RUDSETI.

I wish RUDSETI Madurai to continue this good effort forever.

Message from Bipul Chandra Saha, National Director for RSETIs



The Financial Year (FY) 2021-22 has also seen the third wave of COVID 19 challenge. Many of our RSETIs were not able to function in a regular manner during the first quarter of the Financial Year 2021-22. Inspite of the great challenge imposed by the COVID 19 / Omicron threat all our RSETIs/RUDSETIs have shown their solidarity towards the objective of RSETIs and perform exceedingly well with regard to number of candidates trained and settled. As on 31.03.2022 there are 589 RSETIs / RUDSETIs (4 new RSETIs are added) covering 571 Districts are functioning across the Country under the aegis of Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India which are sponsored by 24 Banks. All these RSETIs/ RUDSETIs are providing training

to the Rural Poor on 59 NSQF aligned courses and 5 MoRD approved courses. As against the annual revised Target of 3.01 lakhs candidates RSETIs have trained 3.14 lakhs candidates (Achievement being 104%). Out of the above total number of Rural Poor trained is 2.82 lakhs (90%). Out of total rural poor trained 2.20 lakhs have settled (78%) and out of the rural poor settled total 1.25 Lakhs have been credit linked (59%). I convey my sincere thanks to the Directors of RSETIs and Faculties and Office Assistants (OAs) for their relentless support which has made this achievement possible.

Further, we have done a notable improvement in reconciliation and realization of pending claims during the FY 2021-22 because of collective efforts of RSETIs and RSETI sponsoring Banks along with the deep involvement of State Directors (SDRs) who have made huge efforts to reconcile the data with SRLMs and subsequent release of Funds. In the coming days we propose to maintain the year wise position of Claims submitted, Claims rejected, Claims received and pending position in excel sheet on monthly basis at RSETIs to enable us to smoothening the claim settlement process.

We had also worked for improving the Quality of training by conducting ToT programmes in various States for engaging the Domain Skill Trainers (DSTs) so that the shortage of Certified Trainers is fulfilled for ensuring quality training. In this regard, I must acknowledge the huge contribution of State Controllers of RSETIs (SCRs) and SDRs for conducting the ToT programmes in their respective States. In coming days we also propose to conduct such programmes in many states to fill the gap of certified trainers in various sectors. In this regard, we wish to highlight that there was a substantial improvement in Grading and CNN compliance position of RSETIs/RUDSETIs in comparison to previous years. There are 541 AA Graded RSETIs and 537 CNN complied RSETIs. Definitely this credit also goes to the RSETI Directors, Faculties, OAs and SDRs.

I am happy to learn that your RSETI is going to publish Annual Activity Report for the FY 2021-22. On this occasion I want to congratulate the Director, Faculties & other staff members and convey my sincere thanks to all your Staff for your performance during the FY 2021-22. I am confident that your RSETI will excel in the FY 2022-23 under various performance parameters including Credit Linkage and Settlement.

Simultaneously, I take this opportunity to thank respected Sri Amit Kataria, IAS, Joint Secretary and Sri Virendra Sharma, Director, Ministry of Rural Development, Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, President NAR, Ms. A Manimekhlai, Executive Director, Canara Bank, Sri A Muralikrishna, GM, FI Wing, Sri Amitava Sahu, DGM and Team of FI Wing of Canara Bank, HO Bengaluru and Nodal Executives of all RSETI sponsoring Banks for their full support which has enabled us to show outstanding performance for the FY 2021-22.

Introduction

Dr. D. VeerendraHeggade, **Padma Vibushanawardee**Dharmathikari, ShreekshetraDharmasthala a great visionary started the RUDSET movement in association with Syndicate Bank and Canara bank. The first institute at Ujire came into existence in the year 1982. At present there are 27 RUDSETIs located in different states of India. The Tamilnadu unit was started in the year 02.02.1987 at *T.Andipatti* (near *Vadipatti*) in Madurai district. The Unit was shifted during 1997 to its spacious own premises at *Perungudi*, (near Airport) Madurai and since then it is functioning from there.

Vision

Empowering youth to share economic progress equitably and channelizing youth power in wealth creation.

Mission

Developing RUDSETIs as rural resources centers for training and facilitating unemployed youth for setting up of Micro Enterprises, resulting in sustainable livelihood and improved living standards.

Philosophy


Transformation of rural youth to acquire productive identity through short duration interventions.


Each RUDSETI has a District Level RSETI Advisory Committee (DLRAC) with representatives of Sponsor Organisations and Govt. Officials. It periodically reviews and assists the progress of RUDSETI. Each RUDSETI is managed by one Deputed Officer (Director) from one of the Sponsoring Bank (Canara Bank). The Director is accompanied by trainer motivators (Faculties) trained by Central Secretariat, Ujire, through National Academy of RUDSETI (NAR) and other reputed organizations along with Office Assistants, Attender and Gardener.

The Training Programmes are mainly of four types:



II. Programmes for established entrepreneurs:

- 1. Skill Up-gradation/ High End Techno & Managerial Enhancement training Programme: Programmes intended to impart additional / advanced skills in their chosen field.
- 2. **Growth Programme:** Training cum counselling inputs are given to help entrepreneurs to plan their expansion, diversification, improve the profit margin, withstand the future challenges etc.

Eligibility norms

Any unemployed youth in the age of **18-45 years**, irrespective of caste, creed, religion, gender and economic status having aptitude to take up self employment or wage employment with some basic knowledge in the related field can undergo training which is totally free of cost. **National Skill Qualification framework(NSQF) Syllabus**, as framed by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) and adopted by Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), is followed and our training programmes are conducted.

Facilities

The institute is located in a **spacious area** measuring about 81 cents on the Airport main Road. There is a beautiful ambience filled with green and breezy open space for **yoga and playing games**. The Main building houses the **office**, **Library**, **Two learning rooms and a Computer lab**. Library is endowed with latest books, project reports etc. There are sufficient enough infrastructures like AV equipments, computer facility, electric circuit learning board etc., The **workshed** is provided with training materials, tools equipments and mockup models etc. for imparting practical training. The **hostel building** consists of 2 dormitory type accommodation halls, Kitchen and Toilets. The entire training is given **free of cost**, including **boarding & lodging**.

Post training follow-up

The in-built system of follow-up and counseling/Hand holding for 2 years is a unique feature of RUDSETI trainings. The follow-up measures with trainees include regular correspondence, individual contacts, branch level meets, Cluster meets Door to Door visits, etc. Our guidance and counseling during these interactive sessions assist the trainees to sort out their problems in launching and sustaining their own self employment ventures.


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR 2021-2022


- Against the target of 20programmes planned this year (inclusive of Skill up Programmes), we have conducted 22programmes (inclusive of Skill up Programmes), covering 644 trainees against the target of 610 with the training days 390 days against the target 390.
- Out of total 22 programmes, 10 programmes were conducted exclusively for women candidates.
- 76 Entrepreneurs Awareness Programmes, (EAP) conducted spreading the message of "Prosperity through Entrepreneurship" to 2507youths.
- 271 follow up meets were conducted and 2826 ex-trainees were contacted for hand holding and counseling
- 586 trainees settled and settlement rate during the year is 91% and cumulative settlement rate is 76%.
- Out of 644 trainees trained, 640 are from rural background which constitutes about 99 %
- Weaker section of the society contributed the paramount share of our trainees (i.e.,) 640 candidates (99 %).
- Two credit camps in different places. One of the camp conducted on 26.10.2021, organized by RUDSETI & KVIC, Madurai at ERK, Mahall, Perungudi, Madurai, for the benefit of RUDSETI trained peoples. 


