



### HIGHLIGHTS OF PERFORMANCE DURING 2020-21

- A Brief Report

The Board of Governors and Governing Council members of RUDSETI take great pleasure in presenting the Activities Report on the working of all the units of RUDSET Institutes during the year 2020-21. The significant contribution of RUDSETI in the entrepreneurial movement, propelling the youth to self reliance, has indeed helped thousands of youth on the path of prosperity and identity.

We are happy to note that given the circumstances like sudden cancellation of trainings and no movement of staff has although hampered regular activities, but it was possible to undertake follow up and other related duties. Despite of the odds, the performance of our Institutes is good.

During the year, RUDSETIs have conducted new training programmes to benefit the vulnerable sections of the society. Prominent among them are training programmes to Jail Inmates and Differently Abled People.

### AWARENESS ON SELF EMPLOYMENT

RUDSETI is spreading awareness on self-employment by organising Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes in rural areas. During the year, RUDSETI organised 1,201 awareness camps on self-employment in association with bank branches, social clubs and Government Departments to motivate 52,752 unemployed youth to take up self-employment ventures. Since inception, RUDSETI has organised 29,198 awareness camps involving 22,73,606 unemployed youth.

### **TRAINING**

During the year, RUDSETI organised **525** training programmes and trained **13,061** unemployed youth to take up Self Employment ventures. Among them **3,346** candidates were trained in Agriculture and Allied Activities, **2,633** in Small and Micro Industries, **2,387** in Service Enterprises, **4,476** in Trade and General Sectors and **219** in Wage Employment training programmes. Of this, as many as **9,237** women (**71%** of the total trained) were trained in different self-employment training

programmes. Since inception, RUDSETI has trained 502,720 unemployed youth to take up Self Employment ventures through 16,390 training programmes. The number of women trainees stood at 228,514 which works out to 45% of the total trained.

### SKILL UPGRADATION PROGRAMMES

In order to help the RUDSETI-trained candidates in acquiring latest technology in their field of activity, 4 Skill Upgradation programmes were organised, thus benefiting 63 entrepreneurs. Rapid change in the technology in all walks of life is the vital reason which prompts units to organise Skill Upgradation by which settled trainees are better equipped with latest technology in their trade and enabled to face the competition. Since inception, 468 Skill Upgradation programmes have been conducted benefiting 10,253 entrepreneurs.

### **SETTLEMENT**

During the year, **9,658** RUDSETI trained youth started their own enterprises and various Bank branches assisted **4,391** entrepreneurs by granting financial assistance to the tune of **Rs. 88.76** Crores. So far, **368,581** youth trained by RUDSETI have started their own enterprises thus, taking the cumulative start-up rate to **73%**, which is a remarkable achievement. **161,118** candidates trained by us have so far availed financial assistance from banks to the tune of **Rs. 2160.12** Crores for starting the ventures.

### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES**

26 Rural Development Programmes were organised to train 1,072 participants during the year. The programmes were conducted for the benefit of farming community and other rural folk. Since inception, 1,724 Rural Development Programmes have been organised to benefit 82,697 participants.

### **HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES**

During the reporting year, **35** Human Resource Development Programmes were organised to train **1,181** 



participants. Since inception, **1,068** Human Resource Development Programmes have been organised for the benefit of **41,864** participants.

### SENSITISATION PROGRAMMES

**287** Sensitisation Programmes were organised to sensitise **12,785** participants during the year. The programmes were conducted to create awareness about RUDSETI to Govt. officials, Bank Managers, NGOs etc. Since inception, **3,128** Sensitisation Programmes have been organised to sensitise **126,529** participants.

### **SHARE OF WEAKER SECTIONS**

RUDSETI has been engaged in enabling unemployed rural youth to become self reliant through motivation and training without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion or economic status. However, by default, majority of our trainees are from weaker sections of the society. The composition of weaker sections in the training programmes is as follows:

### **GRANTS TO RUDSETI**

### TRAINING DAYS

A total number of **7,703** man-days were utilised during the year for the training, which works out to an average of **285** days per Institute.

### FINANCIAL AUDIT OF RUDSETI UNITS

In order to strengthen the existing systems and procedures, financial audit of all the units were undertaken in accordance with the extant policy of RUDSETI.

### **COLLABORATIONS**

Collaboration of RUDSETI with developmental agencies, institutions, voluntary organisations and government departments to achieve the common objectives has proved mutually beneficial. As in the past, this year also, RUDSETI continued its fruitful association with premier organisations like NABARD, SIDBI, DIC, KVIC, DRDAs, State Departments etc.

Several Central/State ministers, bureaucrats, Executives from premier organisations like RBI, NABARD, SIDBI, Sponsor Banks and other nationalised Banks, social workers, other dignitaries from all walks of life from different parts of the country and also from abroad visited our units. From the visits of these distinguished guests, RUDSETI has benefited a lot.

With strong identity under the visionary leadership of **Dr D Veerendra Heggade**, President of RUDSET Institutes and enabled by unstinted support and continued guidance from **Canara Bank**, we rededicate ourselves to the cause of self employment.

# PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT SPONSORED SCHEME

### **PMEGP**

Due to spread of pandemic COVID -19, few Institutes postponed/cancelled training programmes on Government instructions.
