

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF PERFORMANCE DURING 2021-22**

The Board of Governors and Governing Council members of RUDSETI take great pleasure in presenting the Activities Report on the working of all 27 units of RUDSET Institutes during the year 2021-22. The significant contribution of RUDSETI in the entrepreneurial movement, propelling the youth to self-reliance, has indeed helped thousands of youth on the path of prosperity and identity.

During the year, RUDSETIs have conducted new training programmes to benefit the vulnerable sections of the society. Prominent among them are training programmes to Jail Inmates, Transgender members and Differently Abled People.

#### **AWARENESS ON SELF-EMPLOYMENT**

RUDSETI is spreading awareness on self-employment by organising Entrepreneurship Awareness Programmes in rural areas. During the year, RUDSETI organised 1,953 awareness camps on self-employment in association with bank branches, social clubs and Government Departments to motivate 81,144 unemployed youth to take up self-employment ventures. Since inception, RUDSETI has organised 31,151 awareness camps involving 23,54,750 unemployed youth.

#### **TRAINING**

During the year, RUDSETI organised 608 training programmes and trained 15,923 unemployed youth to take up Self Employment ventures. Among them 2,514 candidates were trained in Agriculture and Allied Activities, 4,052 in Small and Micro Industries, 4,525 in Service Enterprises, 4,626 in Trade and General Sectors and 206 in Wage Employment training programmes. Of this, as many as 11,606 women (73% of the total trained) were trained in different self-employment training programmes. Since inception, RUDSETI has trained

**518,643** unemployed youth to take up Self Employment ventures through **16,998** training programmes. The number of women trainees stood at **240,120** which works out to **46%** of the total trained.

#### SKILL UPGRADATION PROGRAMMES

In order to help the RUDSETI-trained candidates in acquiring latest technology in their field of activity, **7** Skill Upgradation programmes were organised, thus benefiting **149** entrepreneurs. Rapid change in the technology in all walks of life is the vital reason which prompts units to organise Skill Upgradation by which settled trainees are better equipped with latest technology in their trade and enabled to face the competition. Since inception, **476** Skill Upgradation programmes have been conducted benefiting **10,420** entrepreneurs.

#### **SETTLEMENT**

During the year, 12,832 RUDSETI trained youth started their own enterprises and various Bank branches assisted 6,296 entrepreneurs by granting financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 63.71 Crores. So far, 381,413 youth trained by RUDSETI have started their own enterprises thus, taking the cumulative start-up rate to 74%, which is a remarkable achievement. 167,414 candidates trained by us have so far availed financial assistance from banks to the tune of Rs. 2223.83 Crores for starting the ventures.

#### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES**

**45** Rural Development Programmes were organised to train **1,507** participants during the year. The programmes were conducted for the benefit of farming community and other rural folk. Since inception, **1,769** Rural Development Programmes have been organised to benefit **84,204** participants.

#### **HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES**

During the reporting year, **58** Human Resource Development Programmes were organised to train **2,218** participants. Since inception, **1,126** Human Resource Development Programmes have been organised for the benefit of **44,082** participants.

#### **SENSITISATION PROGRAMMES**

**346** Sensitisation Programmes were organised to sensitise **11,711** participants during the year. The programmes were conducted to create awareness about RUDSETI to Govt. officials, Bank Managers, NGOs etc. Since inception, **3,474** Sensitisation Programmes have been organised to sensitise **138,240** participants.

#### **SHARE OF WEAKER SECTIONS**

RUDSETI has been engaged in enabling unemployed rural youth to become self reliant through motivation and training without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion or economic status. However, by default, majority of our trainees are from weaker sections of the society. The composition of weaker sections in the training programmes is as follows:

#### TRAINING DAYS

A total number of 10,031 man-days were utilised during the year for the training, which works out to an average of 371 days per Institute.

#### FINANCIAL AUDIT OF RUDSETI UNITS

With strong identity under the visionary leadership of **Dr D Veerendra Heggade**, President of RUDSET Institutes, enabled by unstinted support and continued guidance from **Canara Bank**, we rededicate ourselves to mitigate the cause of the unemployment problem through undeterred confidence and motivation.
